

2nd Grade Supply List 2020-2021



We will be taking extra precautions to limit the spread of germs. Therefore, students will need to have their own supplies and will not be permitted to share. Please include the following items in a hard plastic supply box labeled with your child's name (includes supplies requested by our art teacher, Mrs. Rahner). All supplies will travel to and from school on a daily basis, unless noted below. Please check to ensure that pencils are routinely sharpened and be prepared to replenish supplies as the year progresses. Thank you!

- 1 large or 2 small glue sticks
- 1 box of regular Crayola Crayons (24 ct. max.)
- 1 pair of child scissors (Fiskars or Westcott work best)
- 4 sharpened #2 pencils
- 1 large pink eraser
- 1 set of markers
- 1 black dry erase marker (fine tip) and a dry erase board eraser or old sock
- 1 black Sharpie marker
- 1 highlighter (any color)
- 1 colored pen for self-correcting/editing work (other than black or blue)

Also needed:

- 1 backpack (no wheels)
- 1 lunchbox and reusable water bottle (please label)
- 3 sturdy folders with horizontal pockets along the bottom with the following labels: Home Folder, School Folder, Writing Folder
- 2 Composition books (wide ruled), one labeled Journal and the other labeled Spelling
- A spiral-bound sketchbook for Art (9" x 12" or similar)
- Headphones (in a labeled ziplock bag)
- 1 roll of paper towels to be kept in school for classroom use
- 1 container of disinfectant wipes or spray to be kept in school (if you are lucky enough to find either!)

Please also create a personal care pouch for your child to bring to and from school each day. Ideas for the pouch include pocket tissues, individual hand sanitizer, chapstick, small package of baby wipes and a spare face mask. Students will keep the pouch in their desk for the day and use as necessary to minimize classroom movement and maintain social distancing. *Please replenish these supplies as needed.

All hardcover books should be covered and labeled. They may be covered with book socks, paper, or clear contact covers. **In an effort to limit the materials your child will be transporting to and from school, please keep all textbooks and workbooks at home for now. You will be notified when specific books are needed in school.**
