

Your child will be learning:

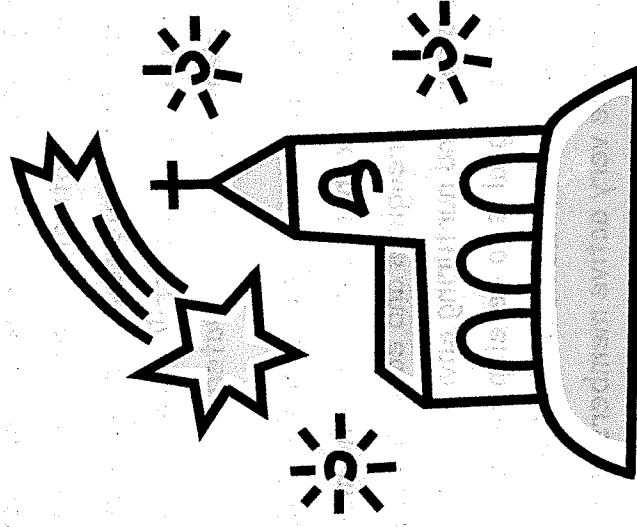
1. School rules and routines.
