

Weekly Literacy Assessment Rubric

The following rubric will be applied to the weekly literacy assessments. Students will strive to achieve no less than a 3 on the weekly tests. If a student works hard to learn the weekly vocabulary skills, phonics skills, grammar skills, comprehension skills, and to improve their writing, then that student will receive a 4 on that week's literacy assessment. Each category of the test was score individually and then averaged together for the final grade.
