Dear Grade 2 Students and Parents,

Welcome to third grade! After successfully completing your second grade work, you are now ready to come upstairs at Holy Name of Mary School. To help you remember all the wonderful skills you learned with Miss David, I have prepared a Summer Packet for you to complete during July and August.

There are two parts to the packet: Reading and Math. Please work on part of each packet each week during your summer vacation.

The Reading packet has a suggested Reading List, sample book reports and a Reading Log. Summer reading is a wonderful way to stay entertained, remain on target, and increase fluency and reading skills. It is required that all students adhere to the requirements listed below.

Students should be reading every day for at least 10 minutes. Keep a list of all the books you read this summer on your Book Log.

Students are required to complete three book reports: one fiction, one biography and one informational. It is recommended that students use a book from the *Who was?* Series as the biography. A few examples are found on the recommendation list. For the informational text, students should pick a topic that interests them and read a non-fiction (factual) book about it. I

have included a list of suggested topics that can be found with the other recommendations.

Please remember to always write in full sentences. A full sentence starts with a capital letter, restates the question, answers the question, and ends with a period.

This summer students are also asked to complete some Math work in order for them to retain the information they learned during 2nd grade. The Math packet reviews different topics they may know and things they should be able to do upon entering 3rd grade. I spoke with Miss David before making the packets.
