**POPE ST. JOHN PAUL II**

"Everyone knows John Paul II: his face, his characteristic way of moving and speaking; his immersion in prayer and his spontaneous cheerfulness. Many of his words have become indelibly engraved in our memories, starting with the passionate cry with which he introduced himself to the people at the beginning of his pontificate: 'Open wide the doors to Christ and be not afraid of Him!'" [*Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI*]

Karol Józef Wojtyła was born on May 18, 1920 in Wadowice, Poland, the youngest of 3 children. His early life was marked by suffering and loss: his older sister died in infancy, his mother when he was only 12, his older brother, Edmund, serving those stricken with scarlet fever and on Feb.18, 1941 his father, who John Paul II said had a profound influence on him becoming "a true worshipper of God."

Karol was ordained alone on the Feast of All Saints in 1946. He further studied in Rome, returned to Poland as Assistant pastor of a parish in Niegowic, and began his vital work with young people. In 1958 he was consecrated the youngest bishop in the history of Poland.

He was elected Pope on October 16, 1978...the first non-Italian priest in 455 years. He took the name of John Paul II, from two previous popes, John and Paul, who had guided the church through tumultuous Vatican II in the 1960s. He was to have one of the longest pontificates in the history of the Church, lasting nearly 27 years. His papacy was profoundly expressed in his love for man.

He embarked on 104 apostolic journeys to 129 different countries. His love for young people led him to establish World Youth Day. He had a deep concern for marriage and the family expressed in his establishment of the World Meeting of Families, his Wednesday catechesis on human love and the founding of the Pontifical John Paul II Institute for Studies on Marriage and Family.

There is so much more to tell about Pope John Paul II who died on April 2, 2005. His final audible words were "Let me go to my Father's house."

He was canonized by Pope Francis on April 27, 2014. His feast day is October 22, when his pontificate was officially inaugurated.

"We can be sure that our beloved Pope is standing today at the window of the Father's house, that he sees us and blesses us." [*Pope Benedict XVI at Pope John Paul's Funeral Mass*]
