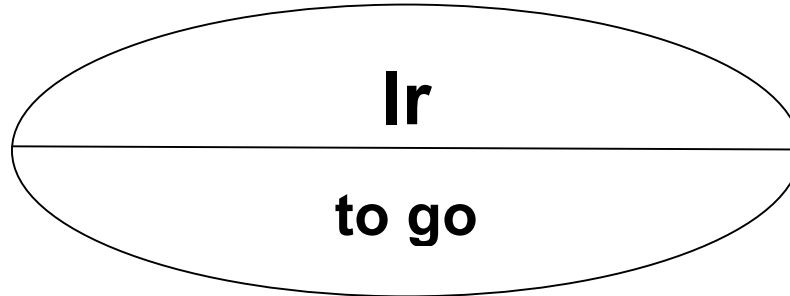

El verbo 'Ir'



Pregunta: How do you conjugate the verb 'Ir'?

The following are the forms of the verb 'Ir':

Yo voy (I go)	Nosotros vamos (We go)
Tú vas (You go)	
Él (He goes) Ella va (She goes) Usted (You go) <small>Polite form</small>	Ellos (They go) Ellas van (They go) Ustedes (You all go)

RULES WHEN USING THE VERB 'IR'

The verb **ir** is used when talking about where people go or are going.

Examples:

I go to the beach.
I am going to the beach. } **Yo voy a la playa.**

1. The verb 'Ir' is always followed by the preposition 'a' (to).

Ir a = to go to Example: **Yo voy a la escuela.**
(I go to school)

2. Don't forget that **a + el = al** Example: **Ella va al supermercado.**
(She goes to the supermarket)

3. The verb 'IR' can be used with the infinitive verb to talk about what one is going to.

Example: **Yo voy a estudiar.** (I am going to study.)

Ellos van a jugar al fútbol. (They are going to play soccer.)
