Theme: Jesus performs his first sign at a wedding feast in Cana.



Summary: This passage from the Gospel of John has been used to recognize the sanctity and sacramental nature of marriage. Marriage is a unique **commitment** of exclusive love that ideally results in many goods for society, such as in children that will enrich the world and the church. The Church

has long celebrated the fact that Jesus performs his first miracle at the Wedding Feast of Cana, which celebrates the special **commitment** that is made through marriage.

Scripture: *His mother said to the servants, Do whatever he tells you.* John 2:5

One day, Jesus went to a wedding. His mother was there and so were his disciples. Everyone was having a good time until the wedding host ran out of wine. The party was about to be ruined when Jesus' mother went to him and asked him to help. Then she told the servants to do whatever Jesus told them to do.

Nearby there were six stone water jars, each holding about twenty or thirty gallons. Jesus said to the servants, "Fill the jars with water"; so the servants filled them to the brim. Then he said to them, "Now draw some out and take it to the master of the banquet." They did as they were told, and when the master of the banquet tasted the water, it had been turned into wine. It was the very best wine he had tasted all evening.

The master of the banquet called the bridegroom aside and said to him, "Most people serve the best wine first and then serve cheap wine after the guests have had too much to drink; but you have saved the best until the last." This was the first of Jesus' miracles on the earth, but it wasn't his last.

When we walk with Jesus every day, we become accustomed to the miracles he performs. He does so many great and wonderful things for us. He supplies everything we need -- a roof over our head, and a nice warm bed. We have clothes to wear and plenty to eat and drink. He is saving the best for last. Eternal life. If we put our trust in Jesus as our Savior, we will live forever in heaven with him.

Dear Father, we thank you for all of the good things which you provide each and every day, but most of all, we thank you for eternal life which we have in Jesus Christ. Amen.

Los Milagros son "Signos"

El evangelio que escucharemos con mayor frecuencia este año es el de san Lucas, el texto de hoy viene de san Juan; se trata de las bodas de Caná. La importancia de este texto es doble: por una parte, enlaza muy bien con las festividades que cierran el tiempo de Navidad, a saber, la Epifanía y el Bautismo; por otra parte, abre el sentido del ministerio público de Cristo, y en concreto, de sus milagros, a los que san Juan llama apropiadamente "señales."

Recordemos que una epifanía es una "manifestación" de la divinidad, y en ese sentido es una realidad muy próxima a lo que san Juan llama "semeion," o sea, un "signo" o "señal reveladora." Lo importante de los milagros no es el hecho extraño en sí mismo, porque también los científicos y los ingenieros logran cosas asombrosas; lo importa de los milagros y señales que Jesús hará en su ministerio es que en ellos hay un lenguaje que nos habla de Dios, de su Reino, de su Voluntad y de su Gloria.

Cada milagro de Dios es una señal de su presencia cercana y amorosa; cada milagro es genuino es una expresión de su voluntad que nos rehace y nos llama a amarle y servirle con alegría, como pueblo de redimidos que somos.

En particular, tiene su interés este milagro de Caná porque uno tiende a pensar que Cristo sólo hacía milagros para sanar defectos o enfermedades o posesiones diabólicas en las personas. Comparado con lo que implica devolver la vista a un ciego, el milagro de convertir agua en vino parece casi trivial. Pero no fue trivial para Cristo, por dos razones: una, porque no es trivial para él atender al ruego de su Madre; dos, porque cada detalle de nuestra vida es importante para él. Nuestro Dios no cuida sólo de lo grande y voluminoso de nuestra existencia, sino que está atento a lo pequeño y discreto: quien ama no quiere sólo dar vida sino también alegría.

TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

En 1502 el Fraile Nicolás de Ovando y doce franciscanos dieron inicio a la evangelización de América en la República Dominicana. Ellos fueron enviados por los reyes españoles con el mandato de convertir a los nativos "sin les hacer fuerza alguna".

Con los misioneros llegaron Alfonso y Antonio Trejo quienes traían con ellos un cuadro de la Virgen María bajo la advocación de Nuestra Señora de la Alta Gracia. Ellos la llevaron a Higüey, donde en 1572 se le construyó su primer santuario. Poco a poco esta pequeña imagen se convirtió en la Reina del corazón de los dominicanos.

María observa dulcemente a su recién nacido quien yace sobre las pajas. Está coronada y lleva puesto un manto azul rociado de estrellas y un escapulario blanco. Lleva una aureola hecha de doce estrellas. En una esquina de la imagen san José también observa al niño por encima del hombro derecho de María.

El 25 de enero del 1979 Juan Pablo II la coronó por ser la primera evangelizadora del continente Americano. Con ella los doce misioneros trajeron la Alta Gracia de Jesucristo a nuestras tierras.
