**"Hand In Hand In Ministry"  
 2019 ANNUAL  
 DIOCESAN APPEAL**

With the generosity of our Parishioners for the 2018 Annual Diocesan Appeal (ADA), \$179,225 was collected from 505 families and \$70,287 returned to our Parish as a **Rebate** after fulfilling the Diocesan goal of \$108,938.

Our Parish had a 14% participation rate which was low compared to other Parishes in the Diocese.

With our rebate, the Parish was able to accomplish the following: Sacramental Formation Teaching Resources. Institute for Leadership in Ministry tuition for our leaders. Conference and formation training registrations for volunteers and staff. We supplemented funds to help cover expenses with the Parish Mission and projects like PACT membership and assistance to the needy and homeless. Lastly, we helped fund last-minute, unexpected expenses pertaining to our facilities and equipment.

For this year's 2019 ADA Campaign, we pray for a higher participation rate of our Parishioners so that we can benefit from a higher **Rebate**. Our Diocesan goal is set at \$119,861 and our Parish goal is \$200,000. Just over \$80,000 will be our **Rebate** if we are successful in reaching our Parish Goal.

A new benefit this year for the 2019 ADA Campaign is a 2% of the diocese goal going towards Catholic School Tuition Assistance including our Saint John Vianney School!

With our 2019 **Rebate**, we hope to start some projects already being considered in addition to what we were able to accomplish last year.

**"Unidos de la Mano en el Ministerio"  
 EL LLAMADO ANUAL  
 DIOCESANO 2019**

Gracias a la generosidad de nuestros feligreses con el Llamado Anual Diocesano (ADA) de 2018, se recaudaron \$ 179,225 procedentes de 505 familias de estos fondos, \$ 70,287 regresaron a nuestra Parroquia como un **reembolso** por haber alcanzado nuestra meta diocesana de \$ 108,938. Si nos damos cuenta, la participación de nuestras familias es de solamente el 14% que es relativamente baja en comparación con otras parroquias en la Diócesis.

Nuestro reembolso, ayuda en parte o totalmente a cubrir los siguientes costos: Catequesis y otra preparación sacramental, Matriculas de estudio de nuestros líderes que asisten al Instituto de Liderazgo Ministerial, Inscripción de conferencias y capacitación en liderazgo, Misión Parroquial y membresía PACT, asistencia a personas necesitadas y sin hogar. Finalmente, ayudamos a financiar gastos inesperados de última hora con nuestras instalaciones y equipos.

Oramos para que la campaña ADA de este año 2019 tenga más participación de nosotros los feligreses que estamos sentados en estas bancas, y así poder recibir de un **reembolso** más alto este año.

La meta de la Diócesis está establecida en \$ 119,861 y nuestra meta de la parroquia es de \$ 200,000. Lo cual nos permitiría recibir un poco más de \$ 80,000 de **reembolso**.

Algo nuevo de este año es que el 2% de la meta de la diócesis será para dar asistencia a familias para que puedan inscribir a sus niños en escuelas católicas, incluyendo nuestra Escuela San Juan Vianney.

## FAITH FORMATION

**Family Discussion:** In the people whom Jesus chose to be his closest friends—his disciples—we see many of the characteristic foibles of ordinary human beings. We also see the ways that God uses the gifts he gave us to transform us into new people, the agents through whom God will lead others to Jesus and to his kingdom.

Let's consider the person Jesus chose to be a leader among the disciples and whom he sent to "catch people." Based on the evidence found in Scripture, we can imagine what Peter must have been like:

- Peter seems unafraid to speak his mind, yet he is also able to take direction. In today's Gospel, Simon Peter lowers his nets as Jesus commands, but not before reminding Jesus that he and his partners have been fishing all night and haven't caught anything.

- Peter is a leader, a spokesperson for others. Today's Gospel suggests that Simon Peter was a leader in his fishing business. When Simon Peter chooses to follow Jesus, others become Jesus' disciple as well.

- Peter's personality and charisma seem to make him the center of attention; yet Peter learned to be transparent, to let others see Jesus through him.

- Peter possesses a dynamic and open relationship with Jesus. Peter often approaches Jesus and speaks what is in his heart.

Gather as a family and spend some time imagining the person of Simon Peter. Encourage family members to tell details about Simon Peter that they recall from Scripture. Consider these questions: Is Peter someone you would like to be friends with? Why or why not? Do you consider Peter a good leader? Why or why not? Read aloud today's Gospel, Luke 5:1-11. Jesus chose Simon Peter to be the leader of the disciples. Peter continued to be a leader in the early Christian community; we continue to speak of Peter's leadership when we call the pope the successor of Peter. Discuss the role of the papacy and of other leaders in the Church. In what ways do we participate in the mission of the Church by leading people to Christ ("catching people")? Pray for those who lead the Church. Pray together the Prayer to St. Joseph, the Protector of the Church.

**Theme:** *Luke 5:1-11* Simon Peter leaves his fishing boat to follow Jesus. .

**Summary:** The call of Saint Peter comes in a very ordinary manner, especially in comparison to Isaiah's call in today's first reading. Saint Peter's call comes in the midst of a normal day under normal circumstances. Peter had just finished a night of fishing, where he caught nothing, when Jesus invites him and his fellow fishermen to *put out into deep water and lower the nets*. After Peter does this, the nets are filled with fish. Like Isaiah, Peter also felt unworthy of his call, yet it is important to remember that God calls us just as we are and works with us wherever we are in life.

**Scripture:** *Then Jesus said to Simon, "Don't be afraid; from now on you will fish for people." So they pulled their boats up on shore, left everything and followed him.*

One day Jesus was standing by the sea of Galilee. A large crowd of people started to gather around him. He saw some fishermen nearby who were cleaning and mending their nets so he climbed into one of their boats. He asked one of the men whose name was Peter, to put the boat out a little way from the shore. Jesus sat in the boat teaching the people. When he had finished teaching, Jesus said to Peter, "Put the boat further out into the deep water and let down your nets to catch some fish." "We've been fishing all night long and haven't caught a thing, but if you say so, we will let down the nets one more time," Peter answered.

An amazing thing happened! When they started pulling the nets up, there were so many fish that the nets began to break. As they pulled the fish into the boat, there were so many fish that the boat was beginning to sink. When Peter and his fellow fishermen saw this, they were astonished and even a bit frightened. Jesus said, "Don't be afraid; from now on you will fish for people."

The Bible tells us that they pulled their boats up onto the shore, left everything, and followed Jesus. From that day on, Peter and his friends fished for people and brought many into God's kingdom. Jesus wants you and me to fish for people too.

If we will be faithful in telling people about Jesus and his love, we can trust Jesus to bring in the catch!

Dear Jesus, help us to be good fishers for people – faithful to go, patiently waiting, and trusting you to bring in the catch. Amen.

**QUINTO DOMINGO EN TIEMPO ORDINARIO C**

**Historias de Envío**

El tema central de las lecturas de hoy es el envío, que literalmente significa: ser puesto en el camino. Tres cosas conviene reflexionar en este domingo: quién envía, a quiénes envía, y qué caminos los envía.

Empecemos sin embargo por los enviados. En la primera lectura se trata de Isaías, que se reconoce como "hombre de labios impuros;" en el evangelio los llamados son unos pescadores sin mucho éxito. En esos personajes quedan bien representadas las dos grandes limitaciones humanas: el pecado y la insuficiencia o impotencia.

Isaías se ve obligado a reconocer su situación de pecado ante la luz deslumbrante de Dios que lo llama. Los pescadores de Galilea, en cambio, no han obrado mal, sino que sencillamente no han sabido o no han podido lograr lo que querían. Solemos decir: no se les dieron las cosas.

Si uno lo piensa bien, también el pecado es una clase de insuficiencia, aunque interna. Pecamos porque no soportamos el peso del camino. Queremos encontrar un atajo hacia la felicidad o asegurar que sí valemos, que nuestras cosas importan, que nuestras fuerzas y deseos pueden imponerse.

Todas estas limitaciones de los que son enviados terminan por producir extrañeza: ¿por qué el Dios que todo lo puede quiere valerse de instrumentos tan frágiles, tan romos, tan proclives al error y tan capaces de traición? La pregunta se hace más aguda si uno piensa en las historias vocacionales, a veces de final triste, que uno conoce en la Iglesia.

**Dios, que envía**

Esa pregunta que Dios se hace en el pasaje que oímos de Isaías tiene una tensión y una profundidad inmensas. He aquí a Dios que pregunta: "¿A quién enviaré?" No le falta amor, pero sí le falta quién le ayude. Todos necesitan y es tanta su necesidad, que pocos están dispuestos para aliviar la necesidad de otros. El resultado es que Dios se queda como sin ayuda.

Bueno, ¿y no podría Dios resolverlo todo, sanarlo todo, completarlo todo por sí mismo? Sí podría, pero a precio de negar uno de los rasgos que él mismo quiso imprimir en su creatura racional, a saber, su dimensión social. Dios mismo nos creó capaces de interactuar unos con otros. Si Dios, sin intervención de ninguna otra causa, atendiera Él mismo a todas las necesidades y dolencias de cada ser humano, habría una dolencia y carencia que se quedaría sin atender, a saber, la carencia de amor y servicio entre nosotros. Esa parte nuestra quedaría enferma o atrofiada si nunca se diera el caso de que un ser humano sirve con genuina caridad a otro.

Así pues, al crearnos como seres en sociedad, Dios en parte eligió tener que buscar "ayuda" en el ser humano para levantar y redimir al mismo ser humano.
