## FAITH FORMATION

**Family Discussion:** In the Easter Gospel we hear about how the disciples found the tomb empty three days after Jesus' death. We are also told that they do not yet understand the Scriptures or that Jesus had been raised from the dead. That understanding gradually unfolded for the disciples as they began to experience the risen Lord. Similarly, our understanding of Jesus' Resurrection unfolds for us throughout our lives. In the weeks ahead, we will hear how the first disciples moved from confusion, doubt, and skepticism to faith. Their experience can teach us how we too might receive this gift of faith from God.

Gather your family members and ask them to share what they know about the events that happened in the days after Jesus' crucifixion. Invite your family to imagine that they are among Jesus' first disciples. Read together today's Gospel, John 20:1-9. Reflect together on the Gospel with questions such as these: If you had been among the first disciples who heard that the stone had been removed from Jesus' tomb and that Jesus' body was no longer there, what would you think? What did Mary of Magdala, Simon Peter, and the disciple whom Jesus loved think had happened? Recall that this experience is the first indication Jesus' disciples have that he is risen. Throughout the Easter season, we will learn more about how the disciples came to believe that Jesus had been raised from the dead.

Pray together using today's psalm, Psalm 118: "This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad."

**Alleluia! May the Risen Christ fill you with every Grace and Blessing during this Easter Season and Always!**

**Theme:** *Mary of Magdala finds that the stone has been removed from Jesus' tomb. John 20:1-9*

**Summary:** In this passage, we encounter Mary Magdalene coming to the tomb *while it was still dark*. The movement out of darkness into light is the starting point from which Mary and the other disciples come to a **conviction** that something spectacular has occurred. Upon seeing the empty tomb, she runs to Peter and the beloved disciple and they investigate the scene. The Gospel account reports that when they see the empty tomb, the beloved disciple *saw and believed*. The beloved disciple is not named, and so can be anyone who places their trust and **conviction** in Jesus as the Messiah.

**Scripture:** So she came running to Simon Peter and the other disciple, the one Jesus loved, and said, "They have taken the Lord out of the tomb, and we don't know where they have put him!" **John 20:2**

On the Sunday morning after Jesus was crucified, a woman named Mary went to visit the grave where the body of Jesus had been laid. When she got there, she found that the stone had been rolled away from the tomb. She ran to find someone to tell them what she had seen. She found two of the disciples, Peter and John, and she said to them, "They have taken our Lord out of the tomb and we don't know where they have put him."

The three of them immediately ran to the tomb. When they got there, they all saw the same thing, but they didn't all look at it in the same way.

Peter looked and was curious. Scripture says Peter went in the empty tomb and looked around. He saw strips of linen laying around and the cloth that Jesus had been buried in folded neatly and placed where the body had been.

Mary looked and was sad. Scripture tells us that Mary didn't even go inside the empty tomb. She just stood outside the tomb and cried because she feared that someone had stolen the body of Jesus.

John looked and believed. Scripture says that John went inside the tomb and he saw and believed that Jesus had risen from the grave.

Dear Lord, today we look into an empty grave. Help us all to see and believe that Jesus has risen just as he said he would. Amen

### DOMINGO DE PASCUA -- CELEBRAMOS LA PASCUA

“Pascua” es la palabra hebrea que significa “paso”. Cuando los israelitas celebraban la Pascua conmemoraban el Paso del Mar Rojo, cuando el Señor los liberó de la esclavitud de Egipto.

Nosotros hemos heredado el nombre y algo del concepto: estamos celebrando la Pascua de Jesús: el paso de Jesús de la muerte a la vida, de la oscuridad a la luz. Estamos celebrando también nuestro propio “paso”: hemos salido de las tinieblas, estamos en la luz.

Así, el Domingo de Resurrección es la coronación necesaria de la Semana Santa. Si terminamos el Viernes, dejamos sin terminar la aventura de Jesús y sin proclamar lo definitivo de nuestra fe: ni Jesús se terminó en la cruz ni nuestra vida termina en oscuridad. La vida y muerte de Jesús son camino hacia el triunfo. Nuestra vida, también. La vida de Jesús, como la nuestra, pasan por el pecado, por el mal, por la oscuridad, por la muerte... pero solamente pasan, se dirigen hacia la luz, la plenitud, el éxito.

Por eso retenemos el nombre de PASCUA, el paso, y celebramos esta noche que hemos pasado de una vida sin sentido y sin esperanza, oscura y abocada a la muerte, a una vida de Hijos, luminosa y mucho más plenamente humana. Desde hace muchos siglos, los cristianos celebraron este día (esta noche) como LA FIESTA DE LAS FIESTAS, la fiesta central del año entero; y, en ella, el corazón de la fe: la Vida Nueva.

## TODAY'S READINGS

**First Reading** — Peter is an eyewitness: The Lord is risen (Acts 10:34a, 37-43).

**Psalm** — This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad (Psalm 118).

**(1) Second Reading** — All who are baptized, set your hearts on heaven (Colossians 3:1-4) *or* **(2) Second Reading** — Christ our Passover is sacrificed; therefore let us celebrate (1 Corinthians 5:6b-8).

**Gospel** — Three witnesses, Mary, Peter, and John; each responds to the empty tomb (John 20:1-9) *or* Luke 24:1-12 (*or, at an afternoon or evening Mass, Luke 24:13-35*).

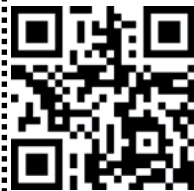
