FAITH FORMATION

Family Discussion: Today's Gospel describes what we can easily imagine as a picnic on the beach. Just as Jesus' miracle at the wedding feast at Cana blesses the love between man and woman celebrated in the sacrament of marriage, Jesus' attentiveness to food and mealtimes raises the possibility that our meal gatherings can be sacred times. In families, the domestic church, our meals together are everyday opportunities to gather and recall Jesus' presence with us. As in the Eucharist, we bring the gifts that God has given us, which have been prepared especially for our Mass, and at our family meals we share gifts that God has given to us and that we have worked together to prepare. This includes the food on the table and also the people who gather around the table. We ask God to bless these gifts and to be present among us in all of our interactions.

Consider a recent family meal: What food was served? Where did the food come from? Who prepared the food? Who served the food? Was mealtime a happy time? Why or why not? Observe that today's Gospel tells about a meal that Jesus shared with his disciples after his Resurrection. Read aloud today's Gospel, John 21:1-14. Reflect on the Gospel reading using the questions above. Talk about ways in which this meal that Jesus shared with his disciples might remind us of the meal we share at the Eucharist. You might choose to plan a special meal together as a family, encouraging each person to participate in the meal preparation. Pray together that Jesus will make his loving presence known in your family life. Pray together the Lord's Prayer.

**From the desk of: Ms. Kathleen Cook,

Theme: John 21:1-19 Jesus appears to the disciples for a third time after his Resurrection and shares a meal with them.

Summary: There are many things that are mentioned in this very short segment of Saint John's gospel: the authenticity of the Resurrection, a glimpse of a group of men set adrift now that Jesus is no longer with them, and an opportunity for Peter to recant his denial of Jesus and to become chief **witness** and leader of the emerging Church. Just as Saint Peter was given a chance to redeem himself from his denial and his lack of **witness**, so too are we given chances by God, who lovingly calls us back time and again.

Scripture: *He called out to them, "Friends, haven't you any fish?" "No," they answered. He said, "Throw your net on the right side of the boat and you will find some." When they did, they were unable to haul the net in because of the large number of fish.* **John 21:5-6**

Several of Jesus' disciples were gathered beside the Sea of Galilee. The group included Simon Peter, Thomas, Nathaniel, and James and John, the sons of Zebedee. Suddenly, Peter said, "I'm going fishing." "We'll come too," the others said. So they got in the boat and they fished all night, but caught nothing."

As the sun came up, Jesus was standing on the beach, but the disciples couldn't make out who it was. Jesus called out to them, "Have you caught any fish?" "Not a thing," the disciples called back. "Throw your nets on the right-hand side of the boat and you'll catch some!" They caught so many fish that they couldn't even pull the net into the boat!

Then the disciple that Jesus loved said to Peter, "It's the Lord!" When Peter heard that, he jumped into the water and headed for shore. The others stayed with the boat and dragged the loaded net to the shore. When they got there, they found Jesus cooking breakfast -- fish over a charcoal fire and some bread. "Bring some of the fish you've just caught," Jesus said. Peter dragged the net to the shore and there were 153 large fish. "Now, come and have some breakfast," Jesus said. Then Jesus served them fish and bread.

Father, we know that you have wonderful blessings in store for us when we faithfully follow our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Our prayer is that we will always be obedient disciples. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.

My Promise to Jesus: The fish is a symbol for all Christians. I will draw a beautiful fish to put in my prayer corner, or give to someone as a gift.

TERCER DOMINGO DE PASCUA

Este tiempo de Pascua es como una prolongada contemplación de la gloria de Cristo y de su victoria. El Señor vive, se ha levantado de entre los muertos, y como él mismo dijo, una vez levantado, ha atraído a todos y a todo hacia sí. Cristo se levanta y con él el pueblo que confía en su Nombre; Cristo se levanta y su victoria da unidad a la creación ya renovada, para presentarla como ofrenda solemne en el altar del cielo.

Pascua es el tiempo más propicio para reunir nuestras voces con los coros de los ángeles en el cielo. A todo lo largo de la Pascua descubrimos de manera nueva que no hay sino una Iglesia, que es el Cuerpo de Cristo, o mejor: el Cristo total, como gustaba de decir san Agustín de Hipona. Tal es la grandiosa visión de la que escuchábamos en el texto de la segunda lectura: Y todas las criaturas del cielo y de la tierra, de debajo de la tierra y del mar, oí que también decían: Al que está sentado en el trono y al Cordero,

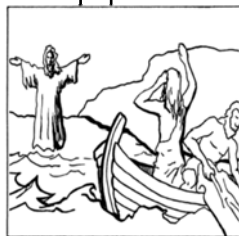
alabanza, honor, gloria y poder por los siglos de los siglos. Y así como durante la Cuaresma nos ejercitábamos en el ayuno y el arrepentimiento de nuestras culpas, ahora, llegada la Pascua, se nos invita a ejercitarnos en la alabanza y en la acción de gracias, porque una cosa es cierta: tanto necesita nuestro corazón aprender a alegrarse en el bien como necesita aprender a rechazar el mal.

Amor del Bueno

Los apóstoles ciertamente habían aprendido muy bien estas lecciones, pues, después de ser injusta y cruelmente azotados \diamond como oímos en la primera lectura de hoy. Fortalecidos por el don del Espíritu Santo, fueron capaces no sólo de dar testimonio sino de sufrir, e incluso gozarse en el sufrimiento, como un modo máximo de dar testimonio de Aquel que les concedía tal fortaleza y tal alegría. Todo, pues, depende de la calidad de amor que nos mueve, como lo muestra el evangelio de hoy. Tres veces negó Pedro a Jesús, cuando llegaba la hora suprema de la dolorosa Pasión; tres veces preguntó Jesús a Pedro si le amaba, cuando la tormenta había ya pasado. Aquel testimonio de amor tenía una razón de ser muy clara: sanar las heridas que habían causado el miedo, la vanidad y el orgullo. Y de aquí podemos tomar una segunda lección muy importante sobre el sentido del tiempo pascual: buscar amor que sea digno de ese nombre. De hecho, el tiempo pascual es como un inmenso arco tendido entre la Resurrección del Señor y Pentecostés. Estos límites cronológicos tienen una razón de ser: tanto la resurrección como la efusión maravillosa del Espíritu Santo son las más grandes expresiones del amor que vence sobre el pecado y la muerte. *Fr. Nelson Medina, O.P.*

SERVICIO A LARGO PLAZO

“Voy a pescar”. ¡Qué anuncio! Si preguntó quién lo dijo, pero no digo que es una frase que está en la Biblia, podríamos decir: “el abuelo o el tío Alfredo”, o admitir “¡lo dije yo el verano pasado!” Pero es una frase tomada de la Biblia, del Evangelio de hoy. La persona que lo dijo una vez afirmó “tú eres el Cristo, el Hijo del Dios vivo”. Así es, ¡fue Pedro! Así que la frase aparece al final. El domingo pasado Jesús dijo: “Así como el Padre me ha enviado, así los envío yo”. Pero Pedro parece determinado a regresar al oficio que tenía antes de ser apóstol, hasta que Jesús interviene, haciendo que Pedro diga ahora lo siguiente: “Señor, tú sabes que te quiero” y la llamada apostólica aparece más clara, “apacienta a mis ovejas”. Así lo hace Pedro. Los Hechos presentan las consecuencias: Pedro declara: “Debemos obedecer a Dios antes que a los hombres”. Como el Apocalipsis dice: “Digno es el cordero”, para recibir el servicio de toda la vida de Pedro y las nuestras.



LIFELONG SERVICE

“I am going fishing.” What an announcement! If asked who made it, and not told it was a Bible quote, we might guess “Grandpa” or “Uncle Fred,” or admit, “I said that last summer!” But it is a Bible quote, from today’s Gospel. The person who said it also once declared, “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.” Yes, it’s Peter! So today’s announcement seems quite the comedown. Last Sunday Jesus said, “As the Father has sent me, so I send you.” But Peter seems determined to return to his pre-apostolic occupation, until Jesus intervenes, making Peter’s later announcement deeper, “Lord, you know that I love you,” and Peter’s apostolic calling clearer, “Tend my sheep.” Peter does so. Acts presents the consequences: Peter declares, “We must obey God rather than men.” As Revelation proclaims, “Worthy is the Lamb”—to receive Peter’s lifelong service, and ours.
