**From the desk of: Ms. Kathleen Cook,  
Director of Religious Education**

**Theme: Matthew 1:18-24** An angel appears to Joseph, directing him to take Mary as his wife and telling him that the child she will bear will be called Emmanuel.

**Summary:** Here we have the preamble to the story of the birth of Jesus. In this story we hear that it was by the *power of the Holy Spirit* that Jesus was conceived in the womb of Mary. We also are allowed entry into the mind of a perplexed Joseph, who being the just man he was, would not expose Mary to ridicule of being pregnant out of wedlock. In a dream all is made clear to Joseph and he follows God's instruction and takes Mary into his home. Again the name **Emmanuel** surfaces and we see again that God indeed wishes to be in our midst, to be with us.

**Scripture:** " 'The virgin will be pregnant. She will have a son, and they will name him Immanuel.' This name means 'God is with us.' " **Matthew 1:23**

Scripture tells us about a visit from an angel. Joseph and Mary were engaged to be married. Can you imagine the thoughts that came to Joseph's mind when he discovered that Mary was going to have a baby and they weren't married yet? He probably asked himself, "What do I do now?" Joseph was a good man and did not want to disgrace Mary publicly, so he decided that it would be better to break off the engagement quietly. While he was considering this, an angel appeared to him in a dream.

"Don't be afraid to take Mary as your wife," the angel said. "The child that is inside her was conceived by the Holy Spirit. She will have a son, and you are to name him Jesus, for he will save the people from their sins."

When the angel of the Lord had spoken and made God's plan clear, Joseph was obedient. He didn't have to understand how everything was going to happen. He didn't need to worry about what anyone else would think. Joseph trusted God and obeyed Him.

Dear God, we are filled with joy by the many lessons we learn when we accept Jesus as God's son. Help us read your Word and listen as you give us the answers to life's difficult questions. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen. [www.sermons4kids.com](http://www.sermons4kids.com)

**First Reading:** Isaiah 7:10-14, **Ahaz** was a king of Israel who was not well thought of. He was not true to the people's covenant with God. He worshipped other gods that he himself had created, and he closed the temple.

**House of David:** When the prophet Isaiah speaks to the house of David, he is speaking to all the Israelites. This is one of the names by which all the people of Israel were known.

**Second Reading:** Romans 1:1-7, **The Letter of Saint Paul to the Romans** is the longest surviving letter that Saint Paul wrote. The Christians who lived in Rome belonged to a small community. Paul wanted to travel to preach in Spain and stop on the way in Rome to visit the Christians. He sent this letter ahead in order to encourage them and to remind them of the teachings of Jesus.

The word **gospel** means the whole message that Jesus brought us. It is a word meaning the "good news."

**Apostleship** is a mission that God gave to Saint Paul, to announce the good news of the resurrection of Jesus (that Jesus conquered death). This is also the mission of all Christians: we are all apostles through our Baptism.

**The Gentiles** are people who are not Jewish. When Saint Paul speaks of Gentiles, he means Greeks and Romans living within the Roman Empire.

**Gospel:** Matthew 1:18-24, **The Gospel of Matthew** tells us about the life of Jesus and emphasizes that he is the promised Messiah, and that the Church is now the Chosen People, the new Israel. Joseph and Mary were  **betrothed**, but they did not live together before marriage. For this reason, when Mary became pregnant, Joseph at first thought they shouldn't get married. But Joseph obeyed what the Lord told him in a dream and he kept his promise to Mary and became Jesus' earthly father.

## ANUNCIOS Y NOTICIAS ESPECIALES

### CUARTO DOMINGO DE ADVIENTO A

#### Homilía

**Temas de las lecturas: Mirad:** la virgen está encinta \* Va a entrar el Señor, él es el Rey de la gloria. \* Jesucristo, de la estirpe de David, Hijo de Dios \* Jesús nacerá de María, desposada con José, hijo de David.

#### La Encarnación del Hijo de Dios

A las puertas ya de la celebración de la Navidad este cuarto domingo de Adviento nos permite asomarnos al misterio de la Encarnación. Y como en el ciclo dominical propio de este año litúrgico leemos especialmente el Evangelio según san Mateo, el texto central de hoy nos habla de la Encarnación como lo hace este evangelista, es decir, más desde la perspectiva de José que de la de María. El relato más conocido, el de la Anunciación, se halla, como sabemos, en el texto de san Lucas. Nuestra oportunidad esta vez es mirar a Mateo, o mejor dicho, mirar cómo Mateo introduce el misterio de la Encarnación desde la óptica de José.

También aquí, como en el caso de Lucas, interviene un ángel, aunque no se da su nombre. El mensaje del ángel es importante en cada una de las palabras. Pido que atendamos muy bien a ellas, porque mi impresión es que no solemos captar unas resonancias fundamentales de la revelación que recibe José, y estas resonancias nos ayudan grandemente en la comprensión del **misterio del Niño que ha de nacer y en la comprensión también de la misión absolutamente singular de José.**

#### "María, tu Esposa, Dará a Luz un Hijo"

El mensaje central está en esta frase: "María, tu esposa... dará a luz un hijo." La clave está en dos cosas: primera, la reafirmación de que María es verdadera esposa de José; segunda, las condiciones en que ese Niño viene al mundo: "ella ha concebido por obra del Espíritu Santo." Estos dos puntos contienen lo esencial.

Los dos elementos del mensaje del ángel no se contradicen. No aparece ahí que ella es menos esposa porque el hijo venga del Espíritu Santo ni tampoco aparece duda de que el niño tenga tal origen único porque ellos vayan a convivir. Muy al contrario, las dos cosas se reafirman: "no dudes en recibir a María tu esposa, porque ella ha concebido por obra del Espíritu Santo." Ese PORQUE está en el texto griego original y muestra que no hay oposición sino reafirmación.

Lo primero que concluimos entonces es que el Espíritu Santo NO reemplazó a José. Es bastante impropia en ese sentido la expresión piadosa que llama a María "Esposa del Espíritu Santo," a pesar de que tal expresión tiene su modo de entenderse rectamente. Si leemos a Mateo, decididamente algo así no cabe. María no tiene dos esposos. El ángel viene a decirle precisamente que la acción del Espíritu Santo lo confirma a él en su condición de esposo único, y en cierto modo, perpetuo, de la Santísima Virgen María. "Ven, Señor Jesús".
