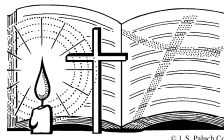

**CHANGE**

The Lenten scriptures issue the call for us to change, to be transfigured, so that we, too, will soon share in the glory of God. What is it that the Lord is asking us to leave behind? Are we willing to take the risk for the promise made by God? These questions are at the heart of the Lenten journey of conversion.

**Theme: Matthew 17:1-9** Jesus is transfigured on the mountain in the presence of Peter, James, and John.

**Summary:** The story of the Transfiguration places Jesus on a mountaintop with the figures of Moses, the greatest of the lawgivers on one side and Elijah, the greatest of the prophets on the other side. The positioning of the three indicates that Jesus is the fulfillment of both the Law and the prophets. The disciples that have accompanied Jesus to the mountaintop are coming to **trust** that Jesus is indeed the fulfillment of the law and the prophets, the messiah. The voice from the heavens declares that this Jesus is indeed the beloved and the one to be listened to and **trusted**.

**Scripture:** *Six days later Jesus took Peter and the two brothers, James and John, and led them up a high mountain to be alone. As the men watched, Jesus' appearance was transformed so that his face shone like the sun, and his clothes became as white as light.* Matthew 17:2-3

As Jesus prayed, His face was changed and His clothes became a dazzling white.

Suddenly, Moses and Elijah appeared and began talking to Jesus. Peter and the others had fallen asleep and when they woke up, they saw Jesus and the other two talking. They were amazed at that wonderful sight! They were in the presence of God!

Dear God, we thank you for the joy we experience in Jesus Christ. Help us reflect that joy in our bright, shining faces. In Jesus' name, amen. [www.sermons4kids.com](http://www.sermons4kids.com)

**First Reading:** Genesis 12:1-4. **Abram** means "noble father." Abram had true faith in God. God promised that if Abram was faithful to God, he would become the head of a huge family. When he proved his faithfulness, God then gave him a new name: Abraham, which means "father of many."

Abraham's descendants (including us) became a great nation, as God had promised. The people of God all over the world are also a **great nation**, brothers and sisters in Christ.

**Second Reading:** 2 Timothy 1:8-10. **Timothy** was a friend of Saint Paul. He helped Paul to spread the gospel and was in charge of the Church in Ephesus, Greece. In the New Testament there are two letters to Timothy.

When we live the life Jesus has planned for us, we are responding to his **calling**. Little by little, God opens our ears so that we will hear this call and follow Jesus.

Because Jesus died and rose again, and we are united with Jesus, we share in his **immortality** (life without death).

**Gospel:** Matthew 19:1-9. When Jesus was **transfigured**, he looked different somehow. His friends saw Jesus as he really is: the Son of God.

The prophet **Elijah** lived about 900 years before Jesus. He is one of the great prophets in the Hebrew Scriptures, or Old Testament. He taught the people to believe in God alone.

**SEGUNDO DOMINGO DE CUARESMA A**

El domingo pasado comenzábamos el tiempo de Cuaresma, el tiempo de purificación, bajo el signo de la seducción y el pecado, del No de la humanidad a Dios.

Y contemplábamos a Jesucristo, solo en el desierto, diciendo Sí a Dios y No al tentador.

En este segundo domingo de cuaresma hemos escuchado que la historia de la salvación comenzó con la obediencia de un hombre, Abrahán. A través de su obediencia todos hemos sido bendecidos.

La voz que le ordena salir de su tierra y dejar su parentela, no es la voz del hambre, ni la voz del euro o del dólar, ni la voz del miedo, ni la voz de la aventura, ni ninguna de las voces que a nosotros nos invitan a viajar.

Era la voz de Dios la que le ordenaba salir.

Era la voz de Dios la que le invitaba a la alianza.

Era la voz de Dios la que le hacía nuevas promesas.

Y Abrahán se puso en camino. ¿Hacia dónde? Hacia una tierra nueva.

Era un viaje espiritual. Una nueva orientación de su vida. Un cambio interior. Una búsqueda del Dios verdadero.

Abrahán dejó sus dioses, sus ídolos y empezó la hermosa aventura del encuentro de Dios con mayúsculas. Y lo encontró y creyó y obedeció y fue bendecido y se convirtió en bendición para sus hijos, su pueblo y todos nosotros.

El libro del Buscón termina con esta frase: "Y le fue peor en las Américas porque la felicidad no consiste en cambiar de sitio sino en cambiar de vida".

Todos nosotros hemos cambiado de sitio, hemos dejado el campo por el asfalto, la vida tranquila por el ruido, la familia por el trabajo, a veces hemos dejado las buenas costumbres por el vicio... ¿pero hemos cambiado de vida?

Lo material y las nuevas obsesiones nos han quitado el deseo y la libertad para este viaje interior, espiritual, que es la búsqueda de Dios.

Yo les invito, hoy, en el nombre del Señor, a cambiar de vida y a dejarse guiar, como Abrahán, por la tierra que él nos prepara y a heredar las promesas que hace a todos sus hijos.

Abrahán no pidió seguridades ni garantías; no dijo a Dios "show me the Money", muéstrame el dinero. El Espíritu era su seguridad y su garantía, su guía y su paz.

En su viaje a Jerusalén, Jesús sube a la montaña con Pedro, Santiago y Juan y allí se transfigura.

La Transfiguración es como un

- \* Un adelanto de su resurrección,
- \* un anticipo del final de su vida,
- \* un momento de éxtasis en el fragor de la batalla de cada día,
- \* un anuncio de la gloria venidera.
- \* La transfiguración es el triunfo, es el destino de Jesús y de todos sus seguidores.

Porque Él es la plenitud, el cumplimiento de la Ley y de los Profetas.

## TODAY'S READINGS

**First Reading** — The LORD said to Abram: All the families of the earth shall find blessing in you (Genesis 12:1-4a)
