

## NOTICE TO PARENTS COVID INFORMATION

Please be advised that if your student exhibits any of the following symptoms during the school day, they will be sent home immediately:

- Fever
- Shortness of breath
- Severe body aches
- Loss of sense of taste/smell
- Red eye(s)
- Diarrhea
- New onset of rash

For the following symptoms, the nurse will assess your child's medical history to determine if there may be another reason for illness, then will determine if your child needs to be sent home:

- Cough
- Runny nose/congestion
- Headache
- Fatigue/malaise

As per New York State regulations, if your child is sent home with any of the above symptoms, he/she MAY NOT return to school until the following conditions have been met:

1. Evaluation by a Health care provider (MD, NP, PA, DO)

PLUS:

2. A NEGATIVE COVID Test

If your child's COVID test is negative, he/she may return to school when:

1. There is no fever for 24 hours without fever reducing medication (Tylenol, Advil, Motrin, etc.)
2. They have an MD note stating that they have been diagnosed with another condition and that they are now cleared to return to school

If your child's COVID test is POSTIVE, he/she may return to school when :

1. It has been at least 10 days since the student first had symptoms
2. It has been 3 days since student has had NO fever without use of medication
3. It has been 3 days since symptoms have resolved
4. Health care provider has provided a note clearing him/her to return to school
