Dear Saint Mary School families,

This message is a reminder to all families who will be coming for in-person instruction during the week of September 8th, 2020.

Governor Cuomo mandates that all of those that have traveled in the last 14 days to a state deemed infectious must quarantine. Students and families whom have traveled to any of these states may NOT return to Saint Mary School until they have quarantined for 14 days since their arrival back in New York. The full list of these states can be found on [Governor.ny.gov](https://www.governor.ny.gov). This list still includes frequently visited states such as Florida, Hawaii, California, North and South Carolina.

Although the first weekly Screening Questionnaire is not due from each student until Monday, September 14th, no student should be coming to school if they can answer yes to any of the listed questions. Reviewing this questionnaire and being up front and honest is the only way to ensure the safety of all of our students. If it is brought to the attention of administration that a student has traveled to a state deemed infectious within the last 14 days, the student will be sent to the isolation room, parents will be called and the student must go home immediately. We appreciate the seriousness with which you are treating this situation.
