

Fourth Grade April Newsletter



Religion: Students will be focusing on living out the Fifth Commandment. They will recognize the importance of valuing human life, respect the gift of life, and take care of their bodies, minds, and souls.

English Language Arts: We are continuing the Fifth Unit in our reading series. In this unit the theme is communication. We will be focusing on comprehension and strategy skills including conclusion, generalization, text, graphic features which will enhance students' understanding of the text.

Math: Students will be using their understanding of fractions and mixed numbers to learn to add and subtract them, first through the use of models, and then through straight computation.

Science: Our studies in science will center around the impact of natural hazards. Students will understand how natural hazards can negatively affect humans and describe some solutions that reduce the impact of them.

Social Studies: In social studies students will study the education system of the new nation with the emphasis on education in New York and will understand the structure of one-room schoolhouses.
