

Happy Easter! He is Risen! Alleluia! Alleluia! Death has been defeated. We share His Resurrection to Eternal Life if we say with our lips, Jesus Christ is Lord!

Easter is such a huge spiritual event that the Church takes 50 days (7 weeks), until Pentecost Sunday, to unpack and attempt to absorb the great mysteries. Easter Season is treated like one "Great Sunday". The Easter Candle remains near the Altar or Ambo during the entire season.

These days, above all, we sing the "Alleluia", and twice at the dismissal from Mass.

Parish Council: Two years ago we formed the current Parish Council and they have served us well under the leadership of Jim Ulrich, Chair of the Parish Council. We began to carefully review the various parish ministries. The Council, working with the Finance Council, also advised and approved the recent changes and renovation of the Parish Offices and Rectory.

This council of 2013-2015 has completed its cycle of service. Now we must choose a new Council. There will be 11-12 members; 7 chosen from each of the Masses, and 5 chosen by the Pastor. We have a lot of work ahead of us.

We need to offer a prayer of Thanksgiving to God for the service of the outgoing council members. And, we need to pray that God will give us **new members** who will faithfully, enthusiastically lead us into the future, advising me, your Pastor. I ask each parishioner to look around your favorite Mass and ask God to indicate to you who should be on the Parish Council representing your Mass community. If you would like to serve, please let me know. Shortly we will hold elections for the new Parish Council for 2015-2017.

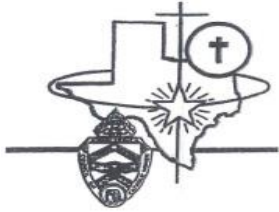
