



Pro-Family/Pro-life Culture

We are working hard to raise up Pro-Life ministries here at Sacred Heart Parish. However, to a lot of people "Pro-Life" ministries means only "anti-abortion", and that can sound like political speech.

I am less interested in traditional "Pro-Life" ministries than I am in building a "Pro-Family" Culture of Life here in our parish. If we are successful creating a Pro-Family culture of

life, with healthy discussion of sexual issues between couples and within families, I am certain that the Holy Spirit will also call parishioners to raise up Pro-Life "ministries", like the Gabriel Project or 40 Days for Life, etc. But first, we have to create a more open dialog and a parish culture of life.

We invite all parishioners to participate in our "Pro-Family/Pro-Life" activities. We will be having workshops throughout the year dealing with various topics. We especially hope parents will bring their teenage children to these events. We have to establish a "Catholic" culture of all topics dealing with sex, family and life.

On October 4, we will be having a Pro-Life Fair in partnership with St. John Paul II Life Center (JPIL). JPIL has been helping us to build Pro-Life ministry here in our parish for the past year. The Pro-Life Fair will be in the Cafeteria and will last all day Sunday, October 4, from 9am - 4:30pm, concurrent with our Religious Education classes. Dr. Jeremy Kalamarides of Vitae Clinic/John Paul II Life Center will provide Ultrasound examinations and there will be many other groups providing valuable information.

I pray that most of you will put this event on your calendar and plan to help us. Those of you who are interested in volunteering to help, please contact Eva Rodriguez or Luisa de Poo.
