



## What is a Parishioner?

*"You are the salt of the earth...  
You are the light of the world."*

Jesus is speaking to all of us together as believers, not just to us as individuals. Together we are the Church, the Body of Christ. Jesus is the real Head of the Church. We receive Jesus in the sacraments of the Church.

Shortly after being elected in 2013, Pope Francis said, "It is an absurd dichotomy to think of living with Jesus but without the church, of following Jesus outside of the church, of loving Jesus without loving the church."

As Baptized and Confirmed members of the Church we are the "light of the world". Jesus tells us to proclaim the Gospel to the entire world. The presence of Jesus in the world is the "salt of the earth."

Many people believe in God and Jesus, but they want to be "secret admirers". If you believe in Jesus, then "DON'T HIDE". Come out of the shadows! Let the Church know you are here! Don't hide under a basket. Tell your parish community, "Here I am! You can count on me!"

This is why we register in our parishes. We register and keep our registration up to date. We participate in the work of the parish; we don't hide from it.

One of the best, most efficient ways to let us know you are here is to use the tithing envelopes. If you use the white envelopes with your name and address on them for six months, then we know you are here. Over 3,000 people come to Sacred Heart Parish each weekend. We have over 1,800 children in our Catechism classes. If you only use the envelopes once in a while, you will be in our system as "visiting", even if you are very active in specific ministry. If we don't see your envelopes how will we know you are here? We have to assume you are not active in our parish. If you forget your personal Church envelope, use the white envelopes available in the entrances to the Church, but write your name and address carefully.

Come out of the shadows into the light! Don't hide! Be the light of the world! Tell your parish, all of us, "Here I am, Lord! I come to do your will... "You Can Count on Me!"

Jesus nos esta hablando a todos nosotros juntos como comunidad creyente, no como individuos. Juntos somos la Iglesia, el cuerpo de Cristo. Jesus es la cabeza de la Iglesia y recibimos a Jesus en los sacramentos de la Iglesia.

Poco despues de ser elegido en el 2013, el Papa Francisco dijo, "Es una absurda dicotomia pensar en vivir con Jesus sin la Iglesia, o seguir a Jesus fuera de la Iglesia, o amar a Jesus sin amar a la Iglesia."

Por esta razón es que tenemos que registrarnos en las parroquias y mantener nuestra membresía actualizada. Participamos en el trabajo de la parroquia; no deberiamos escondemos.

Una de las mejores y mas eficientes formas de hacernos saber que estas aqui es usando los sobres de diezmo. Si usted usa los sobres blancos con su nombre y dirección durante seis meses, entonces sabemos que esta aquí en nuestra iglesia. Mas de 3,000 personas vienen al Sagrado Corazon cada fin de semana. Tenemos mas de 1,800 niños en nuestras clases de catecismo. Si usted usa los sobres de vez encuando, entonces lo consideramos solo como visitante, aun si usted esta participando en algún ministerio. Si nosotros no vemos sus sobres ¿Como podemos saber que usted asiste a nuestra parroquia? Tenemos que asumir que no eres un miembro activo de nuestra iglesia, que eres un visitante. Si usted olvida su sobre personal de la iglesia, use los sobres blancos disponibles en las entradas de la iglesia, pero anotele su nombre y domicilio cuidadosamente.

Salga de las sombras hacia la luz! No se esconda! Se la luz del mundo! Dile a tu parroquia, a todos nosotros, "Aqui estoy Señor! Yo hare tu voluntad..."
