



Pentecost Sunday

Pentecost Sunday is the celebration of the coming of the Holy Spirit. But who is the Holy Spirit? Let me first give you a way in which the mystics and saints speak of the Holy Spirit and then I will share with you four biblical ways in which we refer to the Holy Spirit in the Catholic Church:

Many mystics and saints speak of the Holy Spirit as the love between the Father and the Son. They speak of the Blessed Trinity as the Father eternally gazing upon

his Son and the Son receiving that gaze and gazing back at the Father. As they see each other in love, we can almost hear, the saints tell us, the Father and the Son "sighing" their love for each other as they know they can rest in each other's heart and that shared breath that connects them in love is the Holy Spirit.

In Sacred Scripture, the Holy Spirit is also referred in the following way:

As a dove. We hear in the four Gospels (Matthew 3: 13-17, Mark 1: 9-11, Luke 3: 21-22 and John 1: 31-34) after the baptism of Jesus how the Holy Spirit "descends upon him like a dove." We also hear the words of the Father saying, "this is my beloved son." In our baptism, it is the same Spirit descending upon us as we hear the same words of the Father saying to us "you are my beloved children"

As Fire. We hear in the Acts of the Apostles (Acts 2: 1-11) how after the resurrection and ascension of Jesus his disciples were gathered together "in one place and suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind and filled the entire house. Then there appear to them tongues as of fire." The Holy Spirit is the energy and power of that fire that transforms everything it touches. It is the fire that burns within us everything that does not come from God.

As the Spirit of Truth. The Lord calls the Holy Spirit "the Spirit of Truth that will guide us to all truth" (John 16: 12-15). In a world where there are many voices competing for the minds and souls of the people, the Lord Jesus promised that He will not abandon us. In a world where many people believe in their own subjective truth, the Lord Jesus has promised that our Church will be guided to the truth of who God is, who we are, and God's plan for us.

As the Paraclete or Advocate. In the Gospel of John (John 14:16, 26, 15:26, 16: 7) Jesus also speaks of giving us "another Advocate". Paraclete or Advocate literally means "he who is called to one side." The Holy Spirit is the person of the Holy Trinity who is always to our side leading us to Jesus, revealing who Jesus and the Father are, healing us and giving us what need to live with joy and conviction our Christian life.

May our relationship with the Holy Spirit continues to grow in our lives.
