As we look back the past twenty five years (25) plus, since ALCP/OSS Society started serving in the USA, the WSS has been really a part of our evangelization and collaborators in so many ways.

First and foremost, is the close friendship that exist between the WSS family Board members and the ALCP/OSS. This has also created a great net work of friends Worldwide. This could not have happened without the dedication and commitment of the entire Board members. With this great collaboration, we the ALCP/OSS Society continue thanking WSS for the continuous support first of vocations to Priesthood in our Society. The sixty two (62) seminarians you have supported as Priests (including Bishop Joseph R. Mlola, ALCP/OSS of the Catholic Diocese of Kigoma/Tanzania) are great assets to the Church.

The total number comes to sixty six (66) seminarians as per today. The eight who are in pastoral year are the ones we expect for ordinations to Deaconate and later to Priesthood this year, 2018.

Along with your prayers and support to the priestly vocations, we thank you for your early contributions to the Moshi Airport Academy in 1993 when was just a Kindergarten, now a Grade school. One of our seminarians in philosophy Fr. Nilema's niece, Cimphorian studied at this school.
