Happily, this weekend is Thanksgiving Weekend. The readings invite us to see God's blessings in our life. "In ordinary life," writes Dietrich Bonhoeffer, "we hardly realize that we receive a great deal more than we give, and that it is only with gratitude that life becomes rich." So if you are reading this bulletin, thank the Lord that someone taught you how to read. If you have eaten in the past 24 hours, thank God that you haven't cried from hunger today. If you will sleep under a roof tonight, safe and sound from the hazards of the weather, thank the Lord that you have a shelter. If you enjoy your turkey and pumpkin pie, thank God for his creation. Viewed in this context, ordinary things help us to appreciate the magnitude of God's blessings in our lives, his providential care of us and his persevering goodness. This is the important point that our friends, the 9 lepers, failed to see.

The reason why gratitude in life is so important is not so much that God needs our thanks or that others deserve our thanks; it is rather that failure to be grateful is an indication that we have taken life, things, people, and especially God, for granted. We have lost our sense of wonderment at the miracles happening around us each day. We begin to live ordinary events in a superficial manner and with time, extraordinary events will appear ordinary to us. That will be the end of our joy in life because nothing else can thrill or amaze us.

One who has a grateful heart will always have a depth experience of God even in ordinary events. So let us "give thanks to the Lord for he is good; his love endures forever." (1Chron 16:34). Together with our farmers, we thank God for the work of our hands, and with the rest of the Church, we thank God for the canonization of John Henry Cardinal Newman, and with Leo and Gianna, we thank God for their 40th anniversary of marriage.
