### FACTS Financial Aid Applications for 2021-2022 now open!

FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment will be conducting the financial need analysis for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia/BLOCS & Queen of Angels School for the upcoming 2021-2022 school year. Families applying for financial aid will need to complete an application and submit the necessary supporting documentation to FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment by 5/1/21. Once you complete an online application, you will need to upload copies of your 2019 Federal tax forms including all supporting tax schedules. We recommend you upload all supporting documentation in PDF format online. FACTS is no longer accepting faxed or mailed tax returns. All tax returns must be uploaded in the system. The application is \$30 and must be paid by each family to submit.
