COVID-19 Response Kit PPE - Student

- Ziplock, student name, back up mask, & mini hand sanitizer bottle

Masks

- Bi-layer mask cloth style
- Label each mask with students initials
- Masks with logos, sayings, writing, or graphics that are not appropriate for school will NOT be accepted
- Cloth-style gators/buffs facial/bandanas coverings will NOT be allowed

Classroom Essentials:

- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 2 large containers of Lysol or Clorox wipes.

Access to at home- *If State Mandates a All-Virtual Remote Plan*

- Personal Computer, Laptop, or Device
- Internet Access

The following items may be purchased independently and must be present in class.

- 1- White 1.5 Inch binder used for SOAR Binder System
- 1- 8 Tab Set of Plastic Dividers, equipped with pockets to store papers
- 1-assignment pad; it may be purchased at school or an Agenda Book of their preference
- 1-Calculator – TI-30XS
- 1 pkg. loose leaf paper; (college rule)
- 1-Parent Communication Folder

Note: all books must be covered after 1 week of receiving them. Hard covered books should be covered with book socks or the “old school” brown paper bag. All soft covered books are to be covered with clear contact paper only.

Each semester students are required to be prepared in class with a black or blue pen, a red pen and a sharpened pencil; it is strongly suggested that students invest in friction (Frixion) pens

- 1- Zippered pencil case
- 2-highlighters
- 1-glue stick
- 1-pair scissor
- 1-6 or 12 inch ruler
- Pen Blue or black
- Assorted Markers
- Assorted sharpened colored pencils
- 2 - individual rolls of Scotch Tape (reserved for math)
- 2 - packs of 3x5 index cards (100 in each pack, white, ruled)
- Art Supply Kit posted by Art Teacher
- Other Supply Lists posted by specials
- 1 Marble Composition Notebook for ILA Journaling

Optional: Students are strongly encouraged to rely on the SOAR Binder system to keep all items in one location and act as notebook for all classes. They will be reminded to organize and collate, remove store papers once a term.

* If a student elects to opt for a notebook they are required to have the following subject area notebooks:

4 - 3-subject notebooks (at least 150 pages with pocket folders enclosed) college ruled for ILA,

- Science, Social Studies, and Math
- 1 - 1 subject notebook for Religion
- 1- 2 subject notebook to be shared with Art and Character Ed/Life Skills

* Naturally an additional notebook may need to be purchased once the notebook has been filled.
