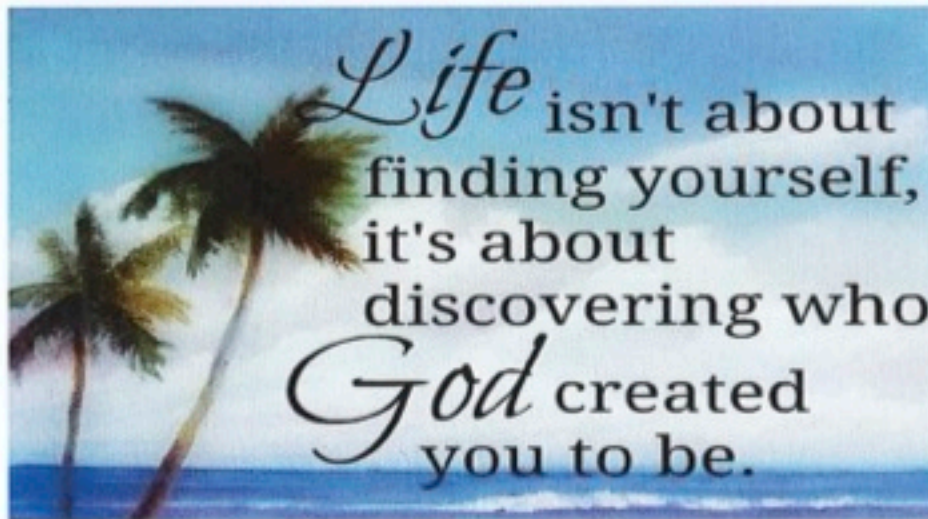

**Come Give Thanks.** Listed below are Covid guidelines from the Diocese of Youngstown.

**For both worship sites:**

*\*Those who are sick or at risk, continue to be dispensed from their Sunday obligation, this also includes Holy Days. June 5th the normal obligation for Sunday Mass was restored.*

*\*Physical contact during the Lord's Prayer and Sign of Peace among non-immediate family members is discouraged.*

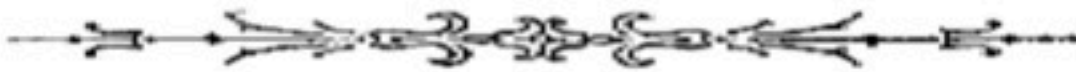
