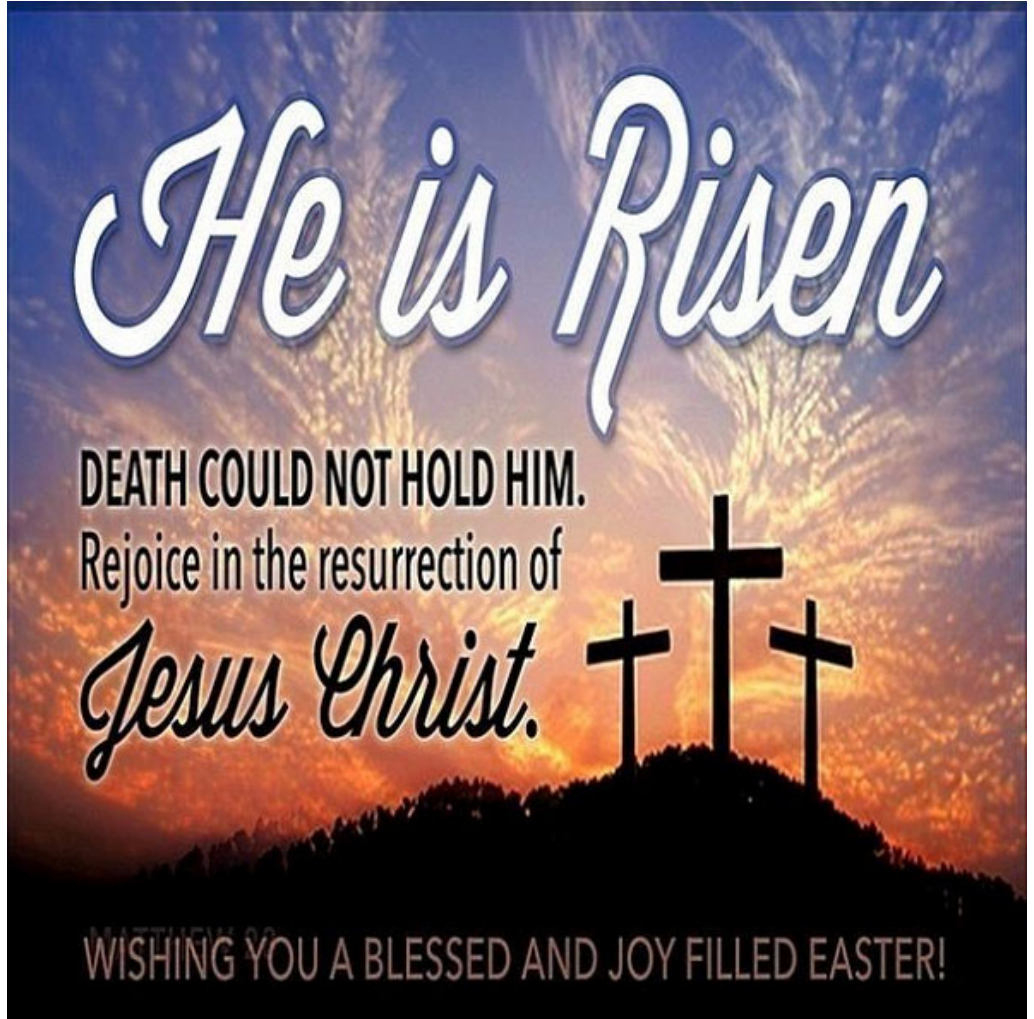
Arrangements can be made at the Rectory. Second Saturday at 12:30pm and Fourth Sunday at 2:00pm

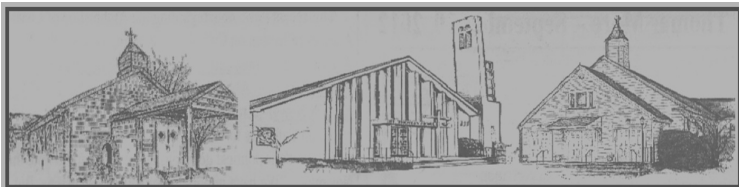
