We continue with the same three focuses this month:

- Using Family of Faith and Blessed(2nd Grade) textbooks to continue to learn and understand the teaching and truth's of our Catholic faith.
- Focus each month on the Sunday readings and learn how to live out the Gospel's in our daily lives especially in our homes and together as a family.
- Commit to daily prayer which will hopefully become lifelong habits for us and our children.

This month of November we will focus on All Saints Day and All Souls Day.

In the Catholic Church, "the faithful" refers specifically to baptized Catholics; "all souls" commemorates the church penitent of souls in Purgatory, whereas "all saints" commemorates the church triumphant of saints in Heaven. ... On this day in particular, Catholics pray for the dead. I have included handouts, prayers and some worksheets to help with this understanding. There are also a lot of great resources out on the internet if you want to learn more and some great videos as well.
