

In keeping with our goal of praying the Stations of the Cross together as a group, we prayed the 6th - 10th Stations together with our 3rd/4th grade students leading us in each station.

Before we began we reviewed the 1st-5th Stations we prayed last week. We talked about how Jesus fell the first time when he had just begun his journey of carrying his Cross (3rd station). The Cross was very heavy and Jesus had been scourged before he was condemned and he was already bloody and in much pain before he took up the Cross. We talked about how Mary must have felt when she seen her Son Jesus carrying this heavy cross to be crucified (the 4th station).

Next week we will finish praying the Stations of the Cross by praying the 11th -14th stations together. We will also be learning about St. Joseph in honor of **Saint Joseph's Day** which is March 19th this year. It is also called the **Feast of Saint Joseph**.

Stations of the Cross are prayed every Friday during Lent at 6p.m. Our families are encouraged to bring their children if possible. They will hopefully remember some of the Stations!
