"Tienen Mosés y los profetas; que les escuchen."

Praying the Word

"Win for yourselves friends who in life eternal will guarantee you a place," the Lord recommended to us last Sunday. Today, as in a sequel, he tells us that this friend is poor Lazarus: the beggar who sat at the doorsteps of a rich man, the hungry who ate from the scraps of the rich man's banquets, the homeless whom we see vagabond in our streets, the despicable person we do not like at work.... In this parable Jesus contrasts two characters: on one hand, a rich man with no name, buried and confined into the torments of hell; and on the other, poor Lazarus with personality recognizable by God (he had a name) and taken to heaven by the angels. This latter is the friend we ought to make ties with to assure us a good usher to the Kingdom. The conclusion and lesson of the parable is in the conversation between the rich man and Abraham. "Please, send Lazarus to my brothers so that they do not end in this place of torment." "They already have Moses and the prophet to remind them." "Yes, but if someone rises from the dead they would give him heed." "If they do not listen to the prophets, even if someone rises from the dead they would not believe." The Lord is clearly speaking about himself, his mission and the seal of credibility from God: his resurrection.

Do we believe him ?

"Ganen amigos que en la vida eterna les pueda asegurar el puesto." Así el Señor nos recomendó el Domingo pasado. Este amigo, nos dice hoy con su parábola, es el pobre Lázaro: el pobre que se sentaba a la puerta del rico, que comía de las migajas que caían de su mesa, el sin techo que deambula por nuestras calles, tal vez, el despreciado que no nos gusta en el trabajo ... En ésta parábola, contrasta, por una parte, un hombre rico sin nombre, enterrado y confinado en los tormentos del infierno; y por otra, el pobre Lázaro con una personalidad reconocible por Dios (tenía nombre) y llevado al cielo por los ángeles. Es este último con quien tenemos que hacer amistad para garantizarnos un lugar en el Reino.

La conclusión y lección de la parábola está en la conversación entre el rico y Abrahán. "Mande a Lázaro para que avisen a mis hermanos para que no terminen en este lugar de tormento." "Ya tienen a Moisés y a los profetas." "Sí, pero si ven uno resucitar de los muertos se recapacitarán." "Si no los escuchan a los profetas, no creerían aunque uno resucite de los muertos." El Señor está claramente hablando de sí mismo, de su misión y el sello de credibilidad por parte de Dios: su resurrección.

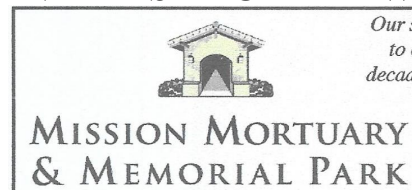
ST. JUDE STREET BILLBOARD



has been restored, thanks to Francisco Vazquez, a parishioner. The carved letters in gold *ST. JUDE'S* have been maintained; but what used to read "St. Jude's Catholic Church" had to be changed. Anyone who is properly catechized will know that the Catholic Church does not belong to St. Jude (indicated by the possessive 's) but to Jesus Christ, to God. The present reading recalls tradition when Christians worshipped and celebrated the Eucharist on the memorial (tomb) of martyrs and saints; hence, our ellipsis "Catholic Community at St. Jude's" for "The Catholic Community that worships and celebrates the Eucharist at St. Jude's memorial". The simplest form would be "St. Jude Catholic Parish", that is, a territorial group of Christians within the Universal Church.
