Praying the Word

Those destined to the resurrection of the dead can no longer die for they are like angels; they are the children of God, the ones who will rise.

The Sadducees were a religious wing in the time of Jesus who did not believe in the resurrection; they defended ideologically their cultural identity but in reality they were pragmatists whose concern was the affairs of the world. Does this not sound familiar in our world today?

To their question, Jesus responds referring to the origin of biblical faith, the burning bush and calling the Lord *the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, the God of Jacob; God of the living, not of the dead.* Consequently, they cannot die those who enter in relation with him through his Covenant, for they are like angels (sent messengers) and are children of God. The resurrection, foundation of Christian faith, is lived as filial relationship with God, faithful to his Covenant and for whom *all are alive*, and as a mission. The Maccabee brothers could offer their lives to martyrdom because they had faith in the immortal life. In this context, Christian marriage responds, not only to a demand of natural order, but to witness (*marturia*) of the Covenant. Before the pragmatists of our times, the believer is challenged to give witness of love and mercy, to the very end, because firmly grounded in the Living God.

Aquellos destinados a la resurrección de los muertos no podrán morir porque son como ángeles; son hijos de Dios los que resucitarán.

Los Saduceos eran un ala religiosa en los tiempos de Jesús que no creían en la resurrección; defendían ideológicamente su identidad religiosa pero en realidad eran unos pragmáticos cuya preocupación era las cosas del mundo. ¿No suena familiar esto en nuestro mundo de hoy?

A su pregunta sobre la resurrección Jesús responde remitiéndose al origen de la fe bíblica: la manifestación de Dios en la zarza ardiente, llamándolo *Dios de Abraham, Dios de Isaac, Dios de Jacob, Dios de vivos, no de los muertos.* Consecuentemente, tampoco podrán morir los que entran en relación con él por la Alianza, pues son como ángeles (enviados mensajeros) e hijos. La fe en la resurrección, fundamento de la fe Cristiana, se vive como relación filial con Dios, fiel a su Alianza y para quien todos viven y, por eso, uno vive la vida como una misión. Los hermanos Macabeos podían entregar la vida porque firmes en la vida inmortal. En este contexto, el Matrimonio cristiano se vive, no sólo como una necesidad de orden natural, sino como testimonio (*marturia*) de la Alianza. Ante los pragmáticos de nuestros días, el creyente está llamado a dar testimonio de amor y misericordia porque arraigado en el Dios Vivo.
