Praying the Word

Rev 7,2-14 Ps 24 1Jn 3, 1-3 Mt 5, 1-12

A great multitude stood before the throne and the Lamb wearing white robes... These are the ones who washed their robes and made them white in the Blood of the Lamb.

How we wish we were numbered among the multitude in white robe! And we are, as well as our constant calling. Today's feast focuses our gaze to the citizens of the new Jerusalem, who are our mentors and intercessors, to walk steadily toward our goal. It is a reminder of God's dream for all his children: *"Be holy as the Lord your God am holy"* (Lev 19,2; 1Pt 1,16).

The readings offer us ways how to reach our destiny. *We are already God's children* and we shall become like God, St. John affirms, *for we shall see him as he is.* Contemplation that transforms. It is like putting ourselves before an intense light that envelops and transfigures us to the point that we too reflect light.

In the Gospel Jesus preaches that the surest way is to follow him, as he lived the word of life he summarised in the Beatitudes. Happiness that no one can take away from us, is not a gift to be given at the end, but one we can experience and possess now. The poor, the mourning, the meek, the pure of heart are those who are truly free. Those seeking righteousness, peace, offering mercy and ready to suffer injustice have discovered the power and the fullness of love. The portrait of Jesus is reflected in the Beatitudes. The disciple who lives by them starts to look like the Son. The Saints, many of them most probably members of our family, encourage us and pray for us to take their path. All Holy Men and Women, pray for us !
