Catholic Schools set high behavioral and academic standards for students which can be achieved only with the support and cooperation of parents.

Therefore, I commit:

- *To send my child to school well rested and nourished.*
- *To oversee and encourage homework and good study habits.*
- *To familiarize myself with the school handbook and the behavioral, academic, and dress code standards of the school so as to support the school staff in enforcing these expectations at school, home, and at school related activities.*

Catholic Schools rely on a steady income from parish subsidies, tuition, fundraising and the work of volunteers in order to continue to provide a high quality education at an affordable cost.

Therefore, I commit:

- *To participate in the major required fundraisers which support school operations such as, but not limited to, the Dickinson County Fair Food Booth, Pasty Sales, Fruit Sale, and any other fundraising activities that may arise.*
- *To pay tuition on a regular and timely basis, according to the selected tuition payment plan.*
- *To volunteer to help at the school, on committees, or with fundraising events whenever possible and at a minimum of 25 hours per school year (specifically for fundraising activities).*

Catholic School education serves to support the teaching of the church and family, working together with them in the faith formation of their children.

Non-Catholic families are exempted from the following, but are encouraged to participate in similar ways at their own places of worship.

Therefore I commit:

- *To attend weekend masses with my children.*
- *To contribute to the life of my parish through stewardship (my time, talent, and treasure).*
- *To encourage my children to become involved with the liturgical ministries such as altar server, cantor, lector, Eucharistic minister at the appropriate age.*
- *To enroll my child in the parish sacramental program if he/she is in need of preparation to receive the sacraments.*

I/we commit to the above, understanding that faith formation is a responsibility shared equally by school, parish, and parents. I also understand that the commitment and cooperation of parents is vital to the quality and future of Catholic schools.
