It's getting real! The school years have started, Fall is officially here, and we're well on our way to Christ the King, the end of the liturgical year. Be sure to skim through the Gospels between now and then to see the full effect! For your prelude music, selections about the second coming, taking up thy cross, discipleship, and denying oneself would be good choices. Psalm 19 is also the Responsorial Psalm for today, so Your Words Are Spirit And Life would be a good choice, too.

The Gospel Acclamation is from Mass of Christ the Savior. The verse is available in your accompaniment book with the Mass setting itself.

Updates on 9/7/21: Fr. John has requested that we use a common Psalm during September. We'll use Psalm 100: We Are God's People. Also, due to the rise in COVID-19 numbers, we've returned to using instrumental music (as needed) during the offertory, and we'll recite the Gloria instead of singing it.

- Let me know what you plan to use for the prelude, Psalm, and postlude, even if you'll use something instrumental. All music needs to be reported for copyright compliance.
