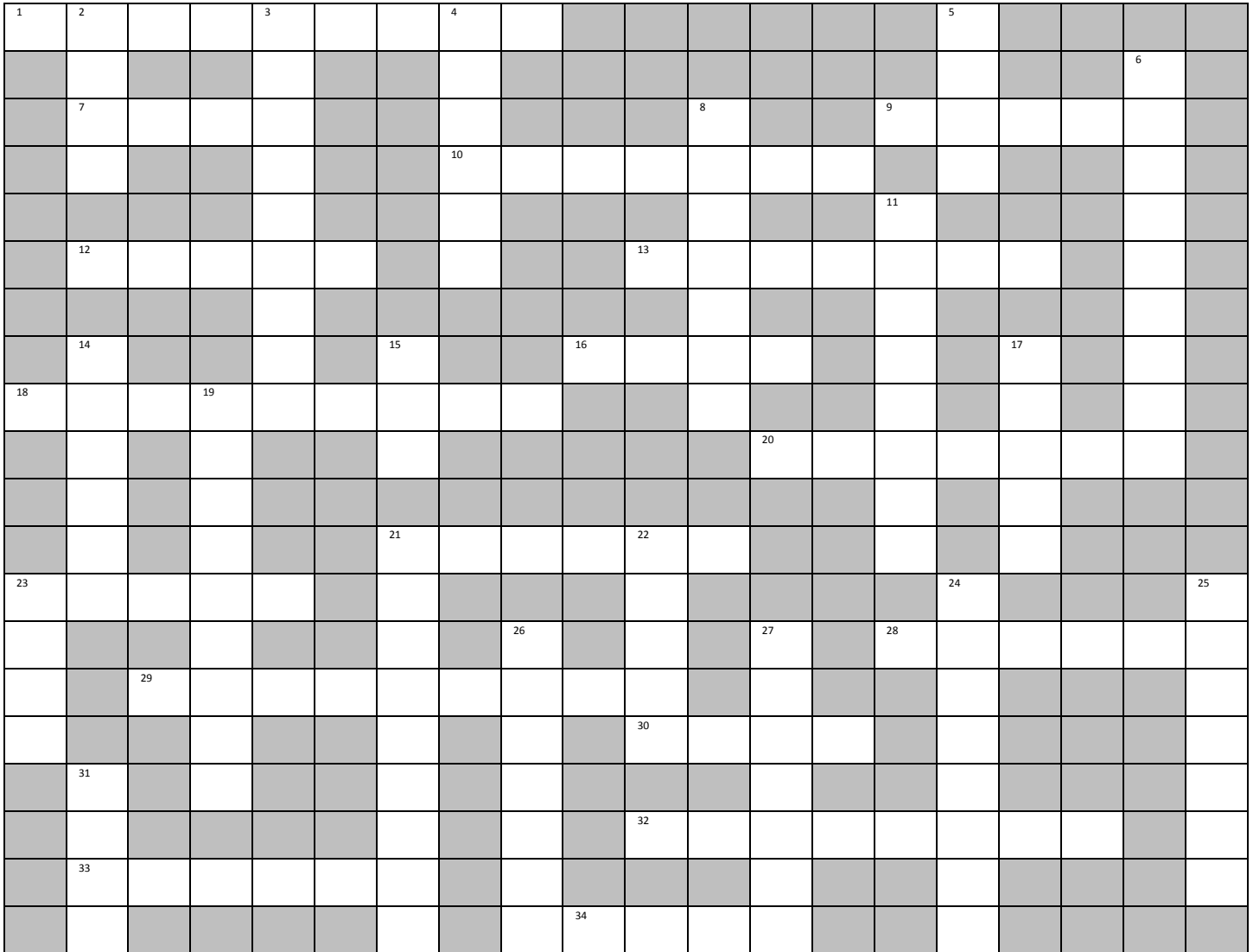


# All Saints Day Crossword Puzzle
