Minutes:

Catholic Identity Exemplary Status Update: SFC was approved by the archdiocese to move forward for consideration. Members of the archdiocese will visit on April 13, 2018 to do an onsite review. Members of this committee will participate in the audit. In addition, parents representing each grade level will also be interviewed as part of the process. Mr. Hilts has created a portfolio that represents mastery of each standard required as part of the application.

Daycare Planning Update: The Daycare director has been hired. Missy Dietrich comes with a great deal of experience and education to support her in the new role. The role will be defined by enrollment and the amount of time required to manage the set up and organization of the new program. First steps including managing enrollment, determining the equipment/materials needed for the program. In the future, aftercare will also be managed by the director of the childcare center. Missy has started in the position and is working towards building the program.

Timeline: Enrollment Forms prior to the end of the school year; Staff will be hired with the intention of starting the center in early August.

Principal Updates: Fine Arts Show: Fine Arts Show is scheduled for Friday, May 20, 2018. Starts at 6:30 and will be held in the gymnasium here at SFC.

Committee Updates:

Auction: No new information from last meeting.

Home and School: Considering a Bingo Bash Party at the end of May or beginning of June. May consider recycling the Candy Bar Bingo concept as it was a success.

Accreditation: See above- Catholic Identity Exemplary Application; Earning this status will positively impact the accreditation process in the future.

Marketing: No new information

Safety: Safety door locks are being considered. Mr. Hilts is pursuing some funding options through the WBSD related to Title I funds and the possibility of accessing grants through the State of Wisconsin focused on school safety. Eagle Scout Project being suggested: Create tool kits for classrooms to support school safety (scissors, Stop the Bleed materials, hammer, etc)

Parish: Work on the parking lot will begin in June. There is a hopeful completion date in August, but the Parish Committee is expecting that a more likely completion date will be closer to October.
