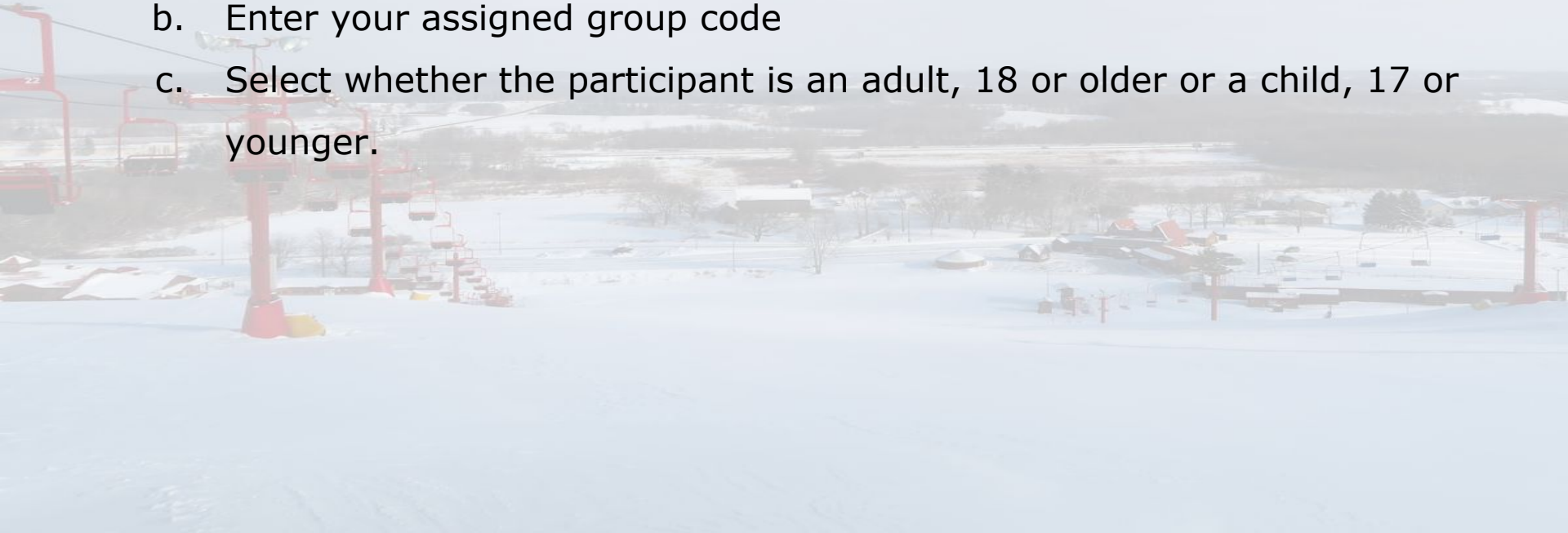

ONLINE PORTAL SELECTIONS

Easier to register today than ever before through our online portal!

- a. Go to shop.skisunburst.com/groups
- b. Enter your assigned group code
- c. Select whether the participant is an adult, 18 or older or a child, 17 or younger.



HOW TO FILL OUT PORTAL SELECTIONS

- 1) Fill out the participants information at top of page.
- 2) Select items for purchase.

First Select One of the Following Lift Ticket Options:

- 1) Lift tickets with Liability Release
- 2) Lift tickets with Liability No-Release (Additional fee \$100.00)
- 3) Season Pass Holder (No Lift Ticket Required)

Second Select One of the Following Rental Options:

- 1) Ski Rental
- 2) Snowboard Rental
- 3) No Rental

Third Select One of the Following Lesson Options:

- 1) Ski or Snowboard Lesson with Liability Release
- 2) Ski or Snowboard Lesson with Liability No-Release (Additional Fee \$25.00)
- 3) No Lesson Needed

CONTINUE TO SIGN WAIVERS

1) Click on each orange waiver box and sign.

2) For the rental form please fill in:

(1) Height

(2) Weight

(3) Street Shoe Size

(4) Skier Type

(a) Skier type 1 : Entry level skier, cautious skiing on smooth gentle to moderate slopes.

(b) Skier type 2: Average skier who has gone down slopes before and feels comfortable.

(c) Skier type 3: Fast skier on slopes of moderate to steep pitch.

3) Make payment with credit/debit card.

LIFT TICKETS / YELLOW TAGS

- Yellow Tags are to be worn at all times during the scheduled club nights as it will act as your lift ticket.
- What is printed on the yellow tags?
 - *Name of Participant*
 - *Name of Group*
 - *Emergency Contact Phone Number*
 - *Scheduled Club Dates*
 - *Rental Information from Online Rental Form (If it applies)*
- Yellow tags are to be brought home at the end of the scheduled visit and must be brought back for the next scheduled visit.
- Wickets will be provided to attach yellow tags to jackets/pants.
- If a yellow tag is lost, it will cost \$5.00 to replace it.

LESSONS

- Group lessons are scheduled to begin at two different times, 4:30pm & 6:00pm
 - *Group lessons will only begin at these times, unfortunately no exceptions will be made.*
- We ask that you arrive with enough time to accommodate one of those two lesson start times.
- Lessons are not mandatory, however they are highly encouraged.
- What does the lesson entail?
 - *An hour and a half group lesson*
 - *These lessons focus on Fun/Skills/Safety.*
- If an individual chooses to do so, they can participate in a lesson each time they come on their scheduled club dates.

CLUB CARDS

- Club cards are issued to each club member and are non-transferable
- What is a club card?
 - *Members can obtain a lift ticket for \$20.00 and rentals for \$10.00 on non-club days/nights.*
- The club card must physically be presented in order to receive this discount.
- Club card will be given to the advisor who will then distribute them to members.

CANCELLATION / REFUND POLICY

- If school is cancelled...
 - *The advisor will make the call on whether or not your scheduled date will be canceled as well.*
 - *If the group date is cancelled, it will be rescheduled. Group members can not show up on the canceled date unless they would like to use their club card for lift tickets/rentals.*
- If the participant is sick or unable to attend a week...
 - *Unfortunately the participant will **NOT** be able to make up the week. It is important to attend all scheduled dates if possible.*
- Is there a chance to get a refund?
 - *Refunds will **ONLY** be given out if the government shuts down the operations of Sunburst Winter Sports Park due to COVID-19.*

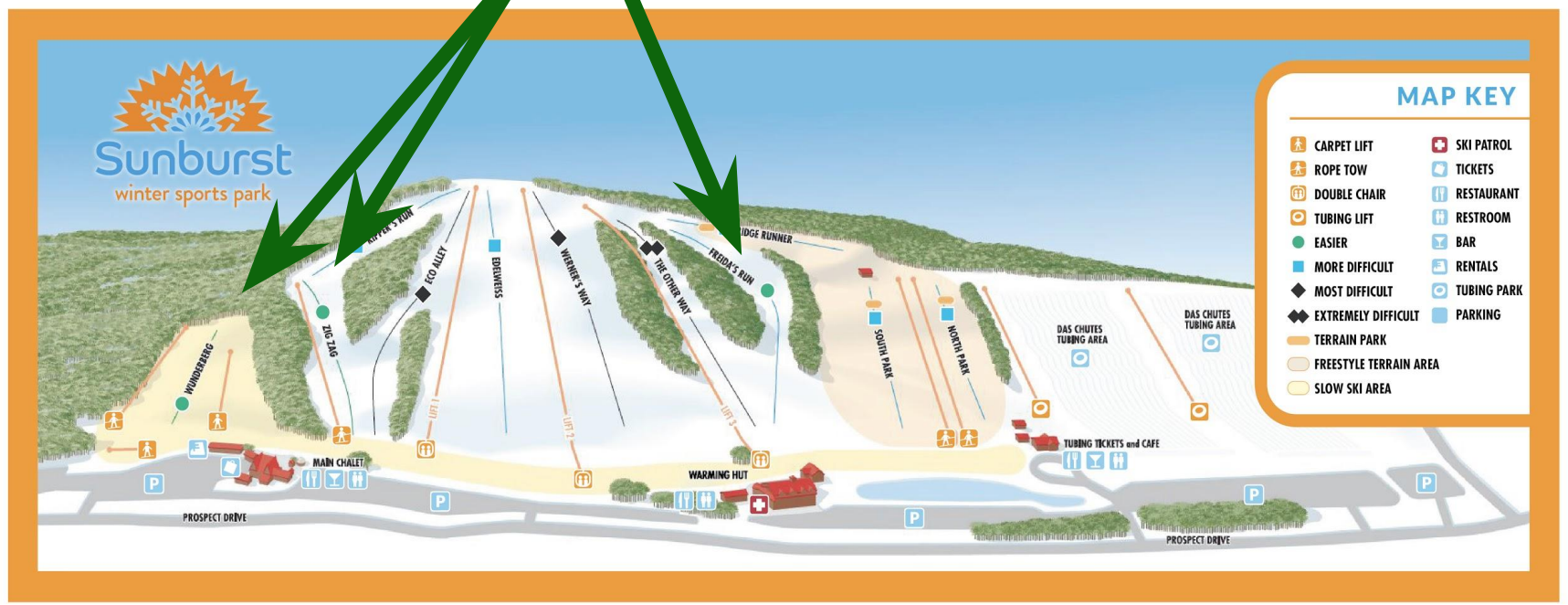

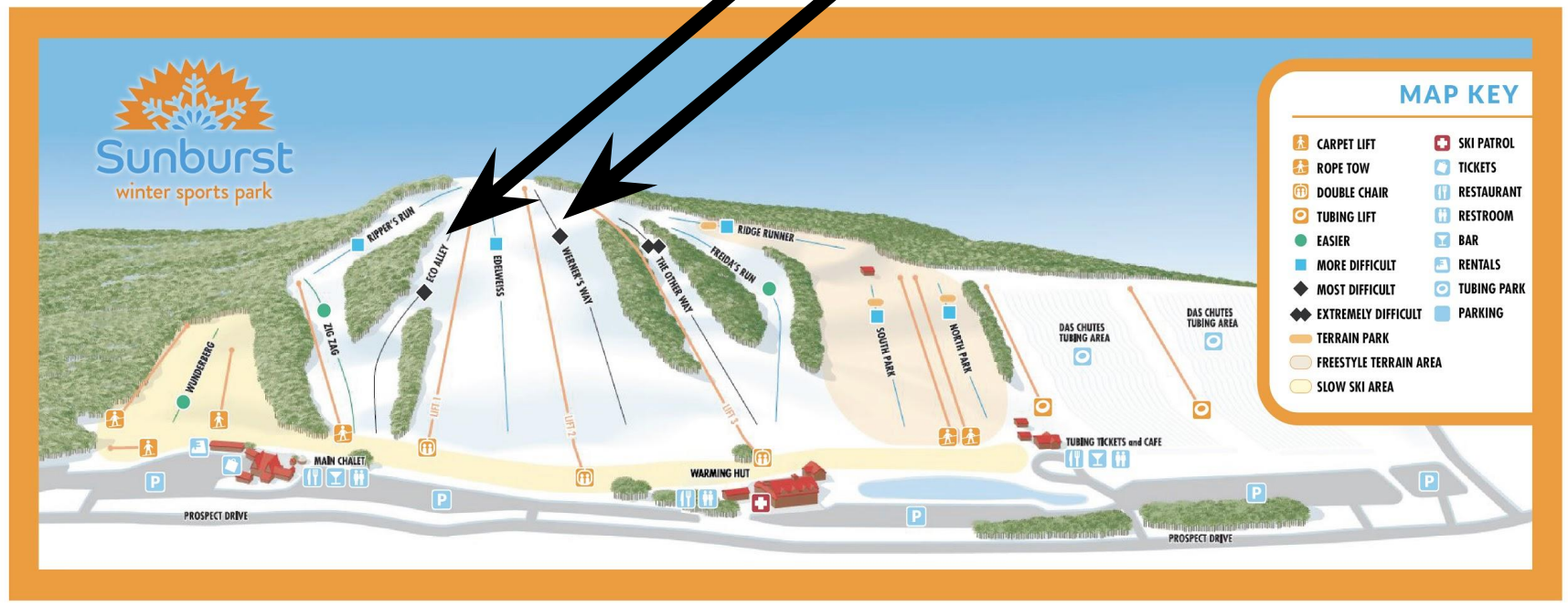

KNOW THE CODE (SKIERS SAFETY ACT)

1. Always stay in control, and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
2. People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
3. You must not stop where you obstruct a trail, or are not visible from above.
4. Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
5. Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
6. Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
7. Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely.

DO I HAVE TO WEAR A HELMET?

- Helmets are not required to be worn by Sunburst Winter Sports Park but are HIGHLY recommended.
- Club advisors may require them to be mandatory for your group.
 - *Please check with your group advisor for more details.*
- Helmets are included in the rental package.

WHAT SHOULD I BRING ALONG?

- Snacks

- *Various food and beverage items are sold in our main chalet on the patio.*
- *Carry in food & beverage items are not allowed in our buildings where food is sold out of.*

- Extra Socks

- *Only wear one pair of socks in ski or snowboard boots, otherwise injuries can happen because it is not a true fit.*

- Extra Gloves or Mittens

- *Glove and mittens get lost all the time, better to be safe than sorry.*

- Just a reminder that in order to make sure we get any lost items back in the hands of the rightful owner, we ask you to please write your name and/or school on the items somewhere so we can identify.

WHAT SHOULD I WEAR?

- Here are some options to consider:
 - Snow Pants
 - Winter Jacket
 - One Warm Pair of Socks
 - Gloves
 - Long Sleeve Base Layer
 - Long Johns under Snow Pants
- **REMEMBER:** it is always better to start with more layers when your out on the snow.

COVID-19

- What are we doing to keep our guests safe?
 - Employees will be required to wear face coverings when indoors/outdoors at all times.
 - Customers will be required to wear face coverings inside buildings.
 - Food & Beverage will be setup in a Grab & Go Configuration.
 - Hand sanitizer stations are installed around the property.
 - Social Distancing will be required.
 - Indoor traffic patterns shall be modified.
 - Tents will be set up outside with adequate airflow for guests use.
 - More outdoor seating will be provided.
 - Lift lines will be reconfigured.
