### Remember from Last Week:

## Some New Thoughts About Generosity:

### THOUGHTS FROM THE CHILDREN:

In today's Virtues assembly, Mr. Waech quizzed the students about how Sunday's gospel and homily tied in to this month's virtue. The kids did a nice job of telling him about the story of the poor widow who had little, but gave everything she had to God. It looks like the children (and Mr. Waech) are doing a nice job of paying attention in church.

### SCRIPTURE PERTAINING TO IT: 2 Corinthians 9:6-8

### SAINT WHO LIVED IT: **St. Giuseppe Moscati**

Giuseppe Moscati was an Italian doctor in the early 1900s. He worked hard to get to know his patients personally and bring them back to the sacraments as well as to physical health. Often he would not accept payment from his poor patients, or he would secretly slip their money back to them with their medicine so as not to embarrass them. Dr. Moscati also trained younger doctors to be generous in caring for both the emotional and spiritual needs of their patients.
