Service Hours are the component of Confirmation Preparation that is viewed as evidence of the candidate's commitment to Christian service. Students are expected to complete a total of twenty (20) service hours by spring of year two. Service is defined as volunteering to "work" for no compensation for someone who is not a family member or neighbor. Service projects **SERVE THE POOR, THE DEFENSELESS, THE NEEDY, THE CHURCH AND SOME NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS**. Service projects should be performed "outside" of organized clubs and activities. *Service projects not listed below MUST be pre-approved by the Coordinator of Religious Education & Youth Ministry prior to completing the service.*
