Individual Confession and Absolution

*At this time students and family members will be escorted
to the Reconciliation stations by class.*

Steps for Reconciliation:

1. Say hello to the priest.
2. Make the Sign of the Cross together.
3. Say: "Bless me Father for I have sinned".
4. Say: "These are my sins..." and tell the priest what they are.
5. Say: "I am sorry for these and all my sins."
6. Listen to the priest explain what to do for your Penance.
7. The priest gives you Absolution – the Lord's forgiveness.
Say: "Amen."
8. The priest dismisses you with a handshake or Sign of Peace.
9. Go back into the church, pray, and do your Penance.

For my impatience,

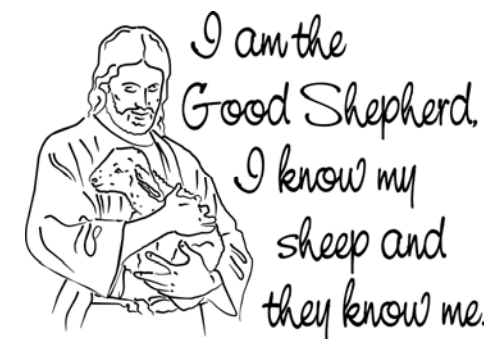
Lord, have mercy.
