

# PLEASE READ

## To safely attend and participate in Divine Liturgy, please follow these simple directions

- Only 23 people are allowed in the church (25%), including the celebrant and the Cantor. For accurate information, in case of a reported positive testing, all persons desiring to attend must sign up on-line for each Divine Liturgy. If you have not signed up for the Liturgy, please do not take offense if you are asked not to enter.
- The doors of the church will be open 30 minutes before Liturgy and closed 5 minutes after liturgy starts. No one will be allowed in after the doors close.
- Everyone is to wear a mask, either the one you bring or one that is provided. DO NOT leave masks in the pew or church but take them and any other items with you after Liturgy.
- Everyone is to use the hand sanitizer provided upon entering and exiting the church. Gloves have been provided and everyone is asked to use them.
- Most movable items have been removed from the church, but DO NOT KISS OR TOUCH any holy objects, doors, stands or equipment, etc. whether you are wearing a mask/gloves or not. Bowing and crossing yourself is acceptable.
- Family members may sit together, but all other persons or groups must maintain a 6-foot distance from each other. Use the designated pews and DO NOT REMOVE the barriers.
- In the gathering area, stand where indicated by the tape on the floor and keep the small children close to you.
- Singing is STRONGLY DISCOURAGED. The Cantor will chant the responses. If you must, sing in a whisper or to yourself.
- Unless going to Holy Communion or absolutely necessary, please refrain from leaving the pews, including children. If you must use the bathroom, use the sanitary practices as posted.
- To receive Holy Communion, each pew is to come up separately, starting from the Christ (right) side, up to the taped line on the floor maintaining distance. Small children should stay by their parent. Father will use a separate wooden spoon for each and will not speak. At you turn remove your mask, open mouth wide, do not speak, cough or sneeze, replace mask.
- Baskets are in the back of the church to collect your donations as you come in or leave church.
- After liturgy, please exit the church promptly, taking everything with you and using sanitizer. Lingering to visit outside the church is discouraged and distancing must be maintained.
