Health Concerns

In the midst of the influenza season and with growing concerns regarding the potential spread of the coronavirus/COVID-19, I realize that you are on the proverbial front lines meeting people with their needs and concerns. I appreciate that and I want to support you as best I can. It seems to me that parishes, schools and institutions in the Diocese of Columbus exercise good judgement and hygienic practices in our gatherings and in our liturgical practice. In regard to our liturgical practice, we exercise the same prudence and charity taken during any influenza season:

- assuring our parishioners that when they are ill or even experiencing symptoms of illness, that they are not obliged to attend Mass, and, in fact, in a spirit of charity should not attend Mass or other functions.;
- taking proper measures to practice good hygiene ourselves and asking all ministers of Holy Communion (ordinary and extraordinary);
- asking all to exercise good judgment regarding coughing, sneezing, the shaking of hands, and keeping surfaces clean.
- Likewise, while the customary sign for the Greeting of Peace is a handshake, it is not the only expression. Individuals may choose simply to turn to those around them saying, "peace be with you."
