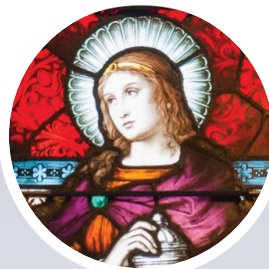

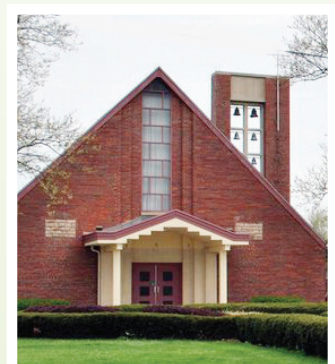

Thank you for sitting in the marked pew and keeping safe distance.

Before Communion

Remove Face Mask as you leave pew for Communion.

Come forward, one side first, then the other side watching distance.

Communion in the Hand is strongly encouraged. If you choose Communion on the tongue and the priest touches your lips or tongue He will have to sanitize his hands before giving Communion to anyone else.

At end of Mass

No congregating in aisle.

Wait until others have cleared the area before leaving your pew.

Pews must be wiped down using wipes provided, so volunteers are appreciated.

Seating is limited at Saint Agnes. Reduced seating is about 60-70 people in the Church. First, we have added Spanish Masses to offer opportunities to attend Mass during the week. Tuesday 7:00 PM Mass in Spanish; Friday 7:00 PM Mass in Spanish; Saturday 7:00 PM Mass in Spanish. Both Sunday Morning Masses, 9:00 and 11:00 will be in Spanish. The 11:00 Mass will be live streamed. We are working on seating in the School Hall via Live Stream.

For "At Risk" parishioners, 70 and older or health restricted, the Bishop has granted dispensation from Mass and encouraged: attending via live streaming or attending a daily Mass when numbers are smaller. Anyone wishing Communion at Home should call the parish office and be put on the list.
