St. Agnes Mass change

We have added a 9:00 AM Tuesday Mass at St. Agnes. That means a 9:00 AM is available Monday-Saturday.

Parish Changes

Father Garland is being assigned as Parochial Vicar at St. Mary, Delaware, Ohio. He will not be replaced at St. Mary Magdalene.

Responsibility for St. Agnes Parish will be transferred to Fr. Eduardo at St. Stephen Parish.

Father Toner will be responsible for St. Mary Magdalene and St. Aloysius parishes.

St. Agnes Rectory will be used by the Missionary Servants of the Word for their lay evangelization program.

Father Watson's assignment is not determined.

Changes will be effective Tuesday, July 14.

Mark your calendar

All three parishes are invited to a Lawn Party, Sunday, July 12, 2:00-4:00 pm. All three parishes are invited to celebrate Fr. Garland and say farewell.

What will happen?

Two weeks ago Bishop Brennan informed me of Father Garland's assignment. At that meeting he outlined what would happen to St. Agnes. Fr. Eduardo of St. Stephen's will become pastor of both parishes. I would be pastor of St. Mary Magdalene and St. Aloysius. An assignment for Father Watson is also in the works. I would work out how to manage mass schedules at St. Mary Magdalene and St. Aloysius.

Some decisions are easy and some are not. We have two Saturday 4:00 pm Masses and will have to reduce to one. Last October at the Clergy Convocation, we were informed of the demographics about numbers of priests. Mean age of active priests is 63. Half of our active priests will reach retirement age in seven years and replacement rate will not cover that. Bishop formed a task force to look at reducing Masses, especially where there were duplicates. In April we had a Zoom conference to discuss the results of the task force. The recommendation that applied to us now becomes a reality. It was recommended that St. Aloysius retain the Saturday 4:00 pm Mass and St. Mary Magdalene retain the Sunday 5:00 pm Mass. There are plans to introduce a youth ministry program following the Sunday 5:00 pm Mass. RCIA is also planned for Sunday evenings. That is the basis for our pending schedule. I did not expect us to reach this point for maybe four more years.

Everyone has their favorite Mass time but we must adjust to the change. There will be four Masses each weekend at convenient times but you will have to go where they are offered. It is a sacrifice. Envelopes will be deposited to the appropriate parish finances.

For St. Mary Magdalene, the Sunday 5:00 pm Mass will not draw a large number, the Sunday Morning Mass will be virtually an "All Parish" Mass. There is a lot of good that can come from having almost everyone at one Mass. P.R.E.P. may move to Sunday after 9:00 AM. Youth Ministry program is being considered for following the Sunday 5:00 PM Mass.

Our plans will be open to change as circumstances change. For the foreseeable future, you will see me at every Mass and I get to see each of you.
