The daily Mass schedule will also change. There is far less heartache in changing the daily Mass schedule.

At. St. Mary Magdalene, Monday Mass and Novena will be at 7:00 pm because of attendance. I will add a Monday 8:15 am Holy Hour with the Novena Prayers and Benediction. Daily Masses will be Wednesday and Friday at 8:15 am. I want to keep the tradition of the Novena alive.

At. St. Aloysius the schedule will change to 9:00 am Masses on Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday. The Monday 2:00 pm Holy Hour will continue.

Holydays will be addressed on individual basis to provide opportunities at both churches. The general pattern will be: 7:00 pm Vigil Mass @St. Mary Magdalene; Holyday 8:15 am @ St. Mary Magdalene; 12:00 noon @St. Aloysius and 7:00 pm @St. Aloysius. This year August 15 is a Saturday and November 1 is a Sunday so holyday obligations are dispensed.

Christmas schedule will be: Christmas Eve 4:00 pm @St. Mary Magdalene and 7:00 pm @St. Aloysius. Christmas Morning 9:00 am @ St. Mary Magdalene and 11:00 am @St. Aloysius.
