What's Next?

One day at a time we will continue to do what is necessary to protect each other. We opened our Churches for a full set of Masses on Pentecost without incident. Some Catholic parishes have just opened, with some on limited schedules. Holy Spirit and St. Philip churches are a joint effort like we are. One weekend there is Mass at Holy Spirit (Reservations required) and the next at St. Philip (Also reservations required). Everyone is dealing with this unusual situation in different ways.

Bishop Brennan has dispensed Catholics from the obligation until after Labor Day. Persons who are ill, or feel uneasy about the situation are encouraged to stay home, watch Mass on TV, or attend a weekday Mass. We are cleaning the Church after each use, providing hand stations and masks, and following safe procedures for Communion, etc. We are almost ready to live stream Masses for our shut-ins and those who choose to stay home for now.

We have a task force to plan for the opening of school. Safety of our children, teachers, and families is the top priority. We will pay for extra services so that we can do things right. We will find new ways of providing a vital education for your youth.

One day at a time, life will go on. We will be creative with what we have. We have an opportunity to vitalize a youth group and are looking at Sunday evenings following the 5:00 Mass. We will offer an Instructions in the Faith program (R.C.I.A.) at St. Mary Magdalene. I hope to expand our devotional program: Holy Hours, Novenas, Bible Studies, discussions groups, etc. Just as the school will utilize online learning, we will offer opportunities for adults. We subscribe to Formed.org from the Augustine Institute which offers a variety of bible studies, instructions, devotionals and even reading materials. It is free for any parishioner to use. Go to "formed.org", sign-in by using your zip code and then select St. Mary Magdalene.

Father Eduardo wants to educate the St. Agnes Youth over there. Our Parish Religious Education Program (PREP) will undergo a change. We have new online program and grant to facilitate it. The Church basement at St. Mary Magdalene will become internet accessible for the school and the parish. Sunday morning presents an opportunity following the 9:00 am Mass.

There are a number of projects at St. Aloysius that we will complete this year. A new sign that will allow us to post messages of coming events. The kitchen has been completed and ready for the Free Community Meals. A new St. Aloysius Social Outreach program is feeding homeless on Sullivant Avenue and looking at other opportunities.

Franciscan Sisters of the Immaculate Heart of Mary will be moving in the rectory at St. Aloysius. I expect Jesse Figuera, a Permanent Deacon candidate, to be assigned to St. Mary Magdalene. Deacon Gordon Mott will continue at St. Aloysius until his future is worked.

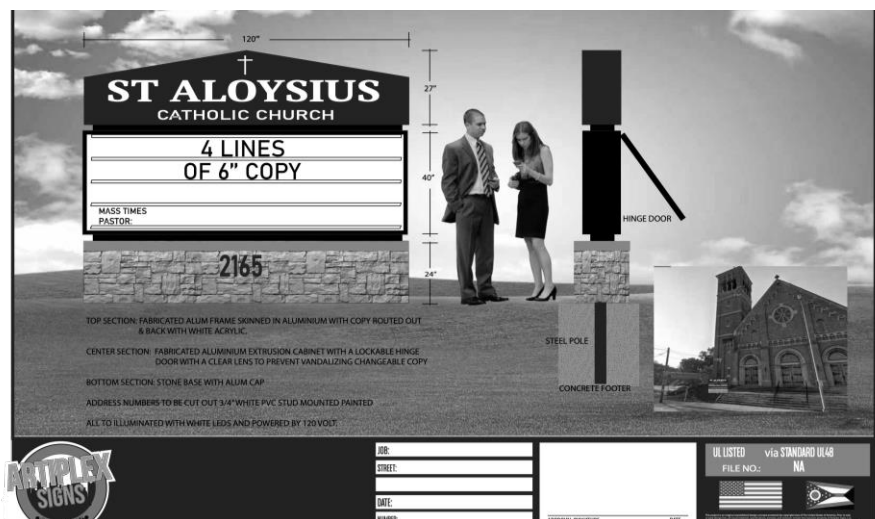
