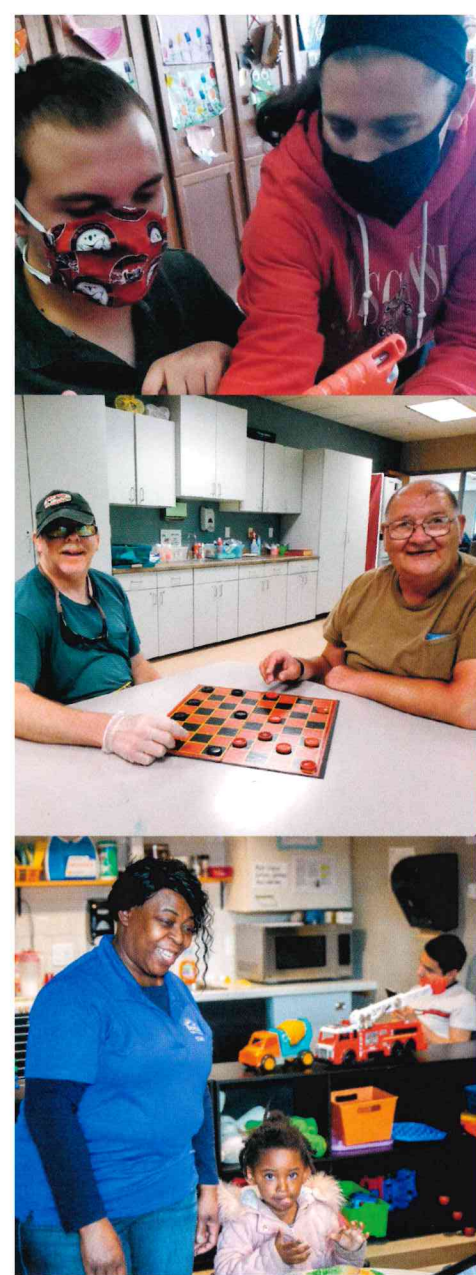
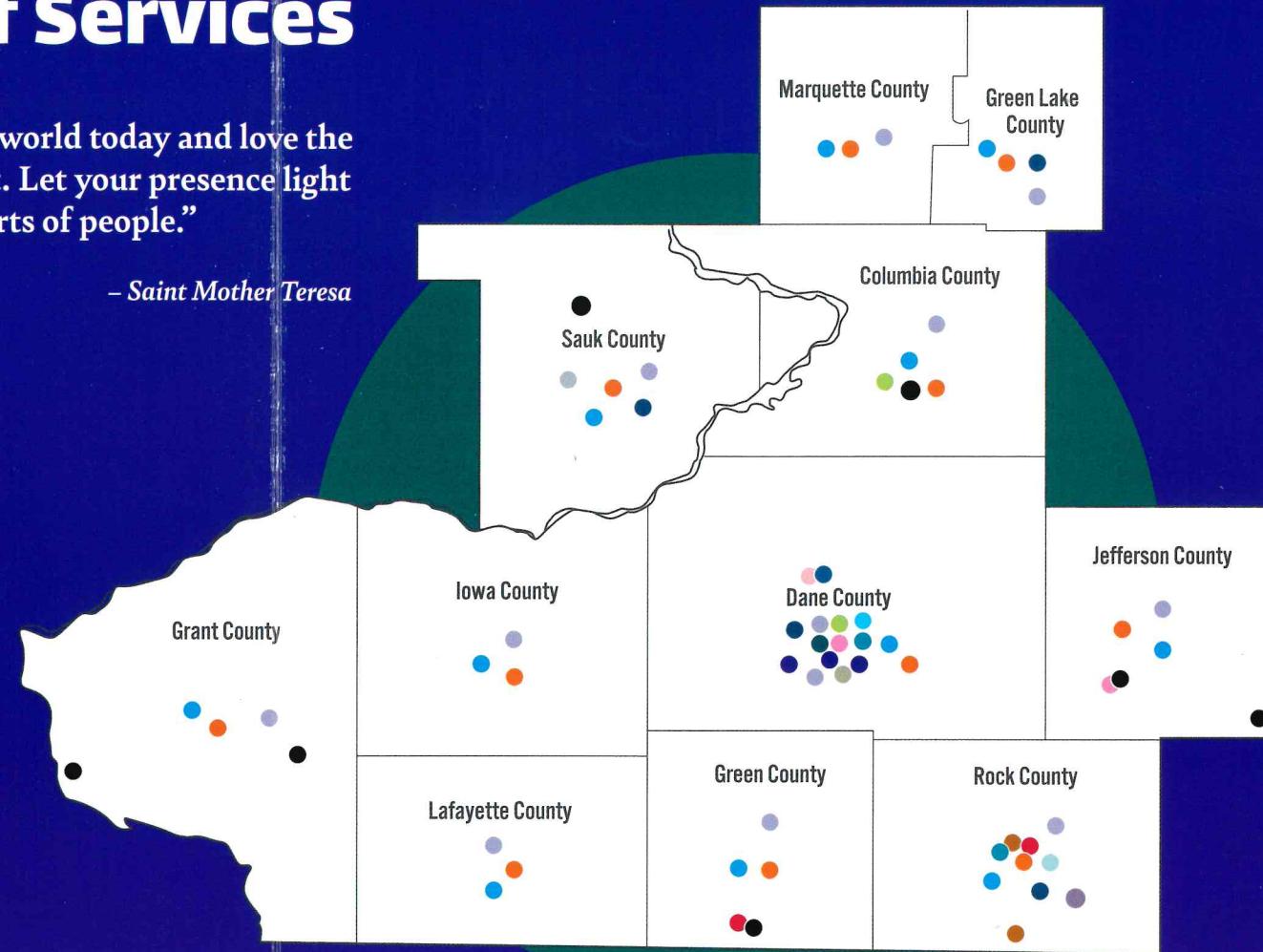


Catholic Charities Map of Services

- **Behavioral Health in Schools** provides individual psychotherapy at the school, for students who might otherwise be unable to attend traditional outpatient services.
- **Building Bridges** serves students in grades 4K-8, and their families, with immediate mental health needs.
- **Parish School Counseling** provides school counseling services to students attending Catholic schools.

- **Choices** educates and guides youth toward healthier choices and improved functioning at home and school, while providing education and resources for the parents, and if needed, referrals for treatment.
- **FACE-Kids** provides group counseling services for Dane County youth and adolescents focusing on social-emotional wellness. FACE-Kids uses a collaborative system as a strategy to provide accessible group counseling in schools.
- **Youth Wellness** provides behavioral health support and referral services to children in 4K-6th grade attending Deerfield Community Center.

- **Family Counseling** offers mental health counseling for individuals, couples, and families coping with stress, depression, anxiety, and other life issues, including trauma.
- **Adoption Resources (WISAPSP)** is a supportive service that covers a wide continuum of needs for Wisconsin's adoptive and guardianship families, adult adoptees, and birth families.
- **The Beacon** homeless day resource center is a public/private partnership working to provide community solutions to help men, women, and children who are experiencing homelessness.
- **Birth to 3** is Wisconsin's early intervention program for infants and toddlers with developmental delays and disabilities.
- **The Adult Day Center** provides a safe and supportive environment for adults 18 and older with physical or cognitive impairments, developmental disabilities, memory loss, and/or those who are socially isolated. It offers meaningful activities, personal care, caregiver respite, nutritious meals, peace of mind, and more.
- **Companion Care** promotes self-reliance of older adults and encourages continued engagement in community life. Companions are professional, compassionate, and trained to assist older adults with in-home support, personal care, companionship, dementia care, and more.
- **Care Team** congregation-based teams offer visits of sustaining presence, reassuring phone calls, friendly visits, and an array of nonmedical services to aging persons and their caregivers.
- **All Saints Neighborhood** features condos, apartments, cottages, assisted living, and memory care for those 55 plus.
- **Community Connections** in Rock County provides community integration and meaningful activities for adults with intellectual and physical disabilities.
- **Community Living** offers residential support for adults with developmental disabilities living in the communities of Marquette and Dane Counties.
- **Rock and Green County Recreation** provides social and recreational activities for Rock and Green County adults with developmental disabilities.
- **5 Door Recovery** is a Catholic Charities Program and residential treatment facility created to help those struggling with substance use disorder.
- **Housing Navigation Services** assists individuals and families experiencing housing insecurity and homelessness, providing personalized and easy-to-understand navigation.
- **Parish Mobile Food Pantries** provide a source of nutritious food to families and individuals facing hunger in rural communities.
