

Dear St Pat's Parish K-8 grade Faith Formation Parents:

This is a note to let you know that registration for the 2021-22 Faith Formation year at St Pats is open. To register your kids for Faith Formation at St Pat's, please go to our website at stpatrickwaukon.com and click on the Faith Formation registration box. *If you don't have a way to access the registration site, give us a call at 568-3671 and we can use an office computer to get you set up. It is important for liability reasons that everyone is registered.*

As in the past, **grades K-6 will meet on their scheduled Wednesdays from 5:30-6:30 PM.** We will be using a program called Pflaum Gospel weeklies. Pflaum contains 32 lessons based on the Sunday Gospels and are written fresh each year according to the liturgical cycle. Each student receives a Catechism handbook with an age-appropriate summary of essential Church teachings. Each week your child meets, we will send home the weeklies for any upcoming weeks when they do not meet, along with simple, easy to follow plans to go through with your child. Grades 7-8 meet from 7-8:30 PM on their assigned nights in the church hall. We will be using *Catholicism 102* from St Mary's Press. *Catholicism 102* invites teens to ponder the journey of life, using the Creed as a roadmap, where we seek to answer the questions "Who am I? and Who is God? The sessions empower engagement: the teens enjoy a lively discussion with each other and their catechists in a safe and welcoming environment. As this program is internet based, teens will have an opportunity, if they wish, to go a little deeper on their own. Each teen will be given a login they can use at the first session.
