*From the Desk of Deacon Chris...***PASSION, JOY, AND HUMOR**

I have just finished reading a book from an interview with Pope Francis titled, "God is Young." It is a short book of around one hundred pages, and Pope Francis responds to questions about young people and their journey of faith and life. In the interview our Holy Father reminds Catholics and all people of every age that, "God is young; He is always new." I was reminded of the movie, "The Passion of the Christ," and the scene where Jesus meets his mother Mary during His passion. Jesus, all beaten, battered, and tortured, turns to Mary and says, "See, mother, I make all things new again." What a wonderful thing to reflect on and remember. Jesus makes all things new again!

I want to share with you the very last question posed to Pope Francis in the book, and his response to the question. The question was, "I would like to end by asking you this: What are the attributes that a young person should never lack?" Pope Francis replied, "Passion and Joy," which seem to me to be excellent attributes for all of us. Having passion and joy in our lives do help keep us young and enthusiastic about life which is a loving gift from God. I was pleasantly surprised with the rest of the Pope's answer.

Pope Francis continued to answer the question with these words, "And from there one can move on to talk about another quality that should not be lacking; a sense of humor. Related to the ability to take delight, to be enthusiastic, a sense of humor is essential in order to breathe. Humor also helps us to be in a good mood, and if we are in a good mood it is easier to get along with others and with ourselves." Does it surprise you that the Holy Father believes a sense of humor is a vital attribute in our lives? Does our busy life allow for a sense of humor? Apparently, the Pope thinks it should.

Sometimes what is happening in our life just seems to follow a theme. I just finished reading the book Friday evening, and Saturday morning Patricia and I attended a Deacon study-day at the Pastoral Center. The topic for the day was titled, "The Magic of Humor: Jest for the Health of It!" Our presenter was Jim Snack who is a well known magician, teacher, and speaker associated with The Humor Project in Saratoga.

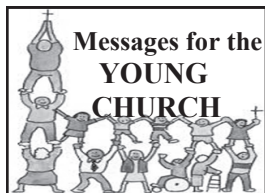
For three hours, Jim shared with us some magic, some stories, and some insight into the importance of humor in our lives. I will leave you with the results of a study Jim shared with us from a Gallup poll. The poll sought to determine the engagement of people in the workforce. The results were broken down into three categories. The first said that 26% of the workforce are engaged, which is to say they are loyal and productive. The second category said that 55% of the workforce are not engaged, which means they are just putting in their time. The third category indicated that 19% are actively disengaged, which means that they have no engagement at all. So, 74% of the workforce are just putting in their time, or doing nothing at all.

I could not help but think that this Gallup Poll could also apply to the engagement of people in the Church. Might the results be very similar with only 26% of the people actively engaged in their faith? Maybe the answer comes from Pope Francis's answer of the attributes we all need; Passion, Joy, and Humor. Maybe, by the grace of God, we can achieve 100% engagement of people in the Church. After all, nothing is impossible for God. God bless.
