First Reading: Sirach 35:12-14, 16-18

Second Reading: 2 Timothy 4:6-8, 16-18

Gospel: Luke 18:9-14

Jesus tells a parable about a Pharisee who went to the temple, and offered up a prayer of thanks because he was not a sinner like the tax collector who was also there to pray. The tax collector was far more humble, acknowledging his sins, and asking forgiveness for them. Jesus said the tax collector's prayer would be heard because, "Everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, while he who humbles himself will be exalted."

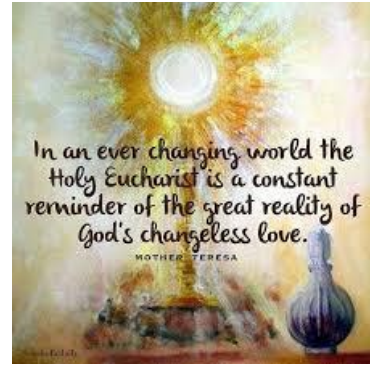

Letters of Eligibility

If anyone wishes to be a Godparent for Baptism or a sponsor for Confirmation, the person needs to be 16 years or older, and have received the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. It is also necessary to be registered in a parish.
