Dear parishioners,

God has told us "Your ways are not my ways." Today's readings reinforce that thought. Paul reminds the Corinthians and us that very few of us are wise, powerful, or noble. That's okay because God chooses to use the foolish, the weak, and the despised. It's why the Church promotes a preferential option for the poor. God's glory is better and more fully revealed through those who are weak and on the margins.

I was very touched at our Volunteer Supper by our university students. An older couple was left with only a table by themselves and went looking for a table that had two empty places. The university students had one extra place and then squeezed together to make the second spot. I am inspired by that kind of looking out for others. We do need to work at that some more. There were also families left to sit by themselves. That's a kind of "being on the margins." We need to be more attentive.

In the gospel—a gospel that we have heard many, many times—we are told of the virtues that delight God's heart. They are not what make comfortable or popular. Blessed are you if you are poor in spirit, meek, merciful, and clean of heart. Also blessed are you if you mourn, if you hunger and thirst for righteousness, if you are persecuted, if you are insulted. Choosing to do the right is not always painless. That choice, however, will be rewarded.
