Ceremony with Archbishop Thompson on Sept. 23

Lumen Christi will be part of a very special ceremony next month honoring four graduates of the Latin School – the boys' high school that was located in our main building – who died while on active duty in the U.S. armed forces.

The ceremony will take place at 1 pm Monday, Sept. 23, when Archbishop Thompson will bless a memorial plaque in the newly rebuilt courtyard. Lumen Christi choirs will sing several hymns for the ceremony.

Among those being honored is Lt. Gen. Timothy Maude, who lost his life at the Pentagon on Sept. 11, 2001. General Maude is the highest-ranking military officer killed on 9/11. His widow will attend the ceremony.

I am very glad that Lumen Christi has been invited to participate. I believe this is a great opportunity for our students to learn about the sacrifices that have been made for our country and to help honor those who gave their lives to defend us.
